Vaya con Dios, Deacon Thomas!

Dear Friends in Christ:

This week's letter comes from Deacon Thomas Swierc:

Where has the time gone? St. Mary's Seminary here in Houston, assigned me to the Co-Cathedral of the Sacred Heart back in August of 2022 for weekend ministry as a transitional deacon. It is difficult to believe that it has been 8 months since I first arrived here and that the time for me to depart is now present. I must confess that I possess a conflict of emotions. On one hand I am excited to be leaving the Co-Cathedral and Houston—because doing so will allow me to return to my home of Corpus Christi, to be ordained a priest, and to serve and minister there. On the other hand, I am saddened to be leaving the Co-Cathedral because I have grown to love all of you who are parishioners and attend Mass here.

Beginning in August, you all were most gracious in welcoming me to the Co-Cathedral parish and community. Patience abounded as I worked to find my bearings with the practicalities of giving the homily on Sunday, and especially when I would need to speak in Spanish. It has been a great joy for me to participate in the various activities of the parish, particularly: celebrating the sacrament of Baptism, and visiting the religious education classes. I have most enjoyed walking with the members of this year's RCIA program, who were joyfully welcomed into the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil. My time at the Co-Cathedral has given me wonderful experiences and memories that I plan to retain forever, and which will help shape my future ministry as a priest in the Diocese of Corpus Christi.

This is my last weekend that I will be serving at the Co-Cathedral. Although I am leaving, I promise that I will return in the near future...but as Father Thomas, to celebrate the Mass with you all! For anyone who wishes to make the drive, my ordination will be on June 17th at 10:00 a.m. in the Corpus Christi Cathedral, in Corpus Christi, Texas. My first Mass will be June 18th at 11:00 a.m. in Kingsville, Texas at St. Gertrude parish. You are all welcome to attend!

Please continue to pray for me and for all the men who will be ordained to the priesthood this year (3 will be ordained for the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston) and be assured of my prayers for all of you, the parishioners of the Co-Cathedral of the Sacred Heart.

+ FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER +

The Fourth Sunday of Easter is called “Good Shepherd Sunday,” from the Communion Antiphon **Ego sum pastor bonus**, which in turn comes from a later verse of today’s Gospel reading (the exact verse appears on this day in cycle B). We hear a few different versions of Psalm 23 today: one at the Responsorial, and at communion, the hymn The King of Love My Shepherd Is (a metrical version of Psalm 23) and an anthem by **Thomas Matthews**. At the Offertory, the choir sings an arrangement of the spiritual **I Believe This Is Jesus** by **Undine Smith Moore**, who was known as the “Dean of Black Women Composers.”

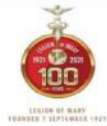
PARISH LIFE

REFLEXION

El Evangelio de hoy es una catequesis para los recién bautizados la noche del Sábado de Gloria. Este trozo del Evangelio de Juan, tiene como una contraposición o contraste con Ezequiel 34. Un pueblo de pastores, Israel, sabía a que atenerse con los pastores que habían tenido sus dirigentes civiles y religiosos. En Ezequiel 34, Dios dice que El mismo vendrá a reclamar sus ovejas y que El mismo las pastoreará. Juan afirma que Jesús es aquel en quien Dios se presenta a realizar esto. Juan lleva la comparación a un punto crítico. Jesús, según Juan, no solamente es el pastor, es el único pastor bueno; Jesús, dice Juan, no solo es el pastor único del rebaño de Dios, es hasta la única puerta por la que las ovejas deben entrar si quieren estar a salvo.

Mayo: Mes de María

La Iglesia otorga este mes a María para conocerla y amarla más.

Tradicionalmente, el mes de mayo se dedica de manera especial a honrar y buscar la intercesión de María como Madre de Dios y Madre de la Iglesia.

"Ella es aquella mujer que se regocijaba en la presencia de Dios, que atesoraba todo en su corazón y que se dejó atravesar por la espada. María es la santa entre los santos, bendita sobre todos los demás. Ella nos enseña el camino de la santidad y camina siempre a nuestro lado. Ella no nos deja permanecer caídos y a veces nos acoge en sus brazos sin juzgarnos". -Papa Francisco, Gaudete et Exsultate, no. 176

Por qué María destaca entre los santos?

Como Madre de Dios, la Virgen María ocupa una posición única entre los santos, es más, entre todas las criaturas. Es excelsa, pero sigue siendo una de nosotros. ¿Por qué ocupa María un lugar tan destacado en la comunión de los santos?

Como reflexionó el Papa emérito Benedicto XVI en Deus caritas est (diciembre de 2005), "Entre los santos destaca María, Madre del Señor y espejo de toda santidad. La grandeza de María consiste en que quiere engrandecer a Dios, no a sí misma. Es humilde: su único deseo es ser la esclava del Señor (cf. Lc 1,38.48)".

María, más que nadie, puede mostrarnos a Jesús, conducirnos a Él y enseñarnos a conocerlo y amarlo, "para que también nosotros seamos capaces de amar de verdad y seamos fuentes de agua viva en medio de un mundo sediento."
