RECTOR'S CORNER

June 18, 2023
Completing the Walk

Dear Friends in Christ:

"We haven't completed the walk yet. The journey is still going on, but we've made progress...we can't stop now; we have to keep going." - Archbishop Joseph A. Fiorenza

On April 2, 2008, the Co-Cathedral of the Sacred Heart was dedicated by Cardinal DiNardo as the fruits of many years of labor on the part of the late Archbishop Fiorenza in his final years as our chief shepherd. What many do not know is that the construction of the Co-Cathedral was just part of his master plan which included plans for the demolition of the old church, expansion of parking, the building of a green space, and the creation of an endowment to help maintain these facilities over the years.

Unfortunately, progress on these other elements came to a screeching halt when Hurricane Ike struck that summer and fundraising efforts were diverted towards hurricane relief. However, as I shared when the construction of the Archbishop Joseph A. Fiorenza Plaza was announced, the alignment of the Co-Cathedral's fifteenth anniversary with the passing of Archbishop Fiorenza this past fall has rejuvenated the desire to bring his vision to fruition.

Therefore, this weekend, along with Suzanne O'Neil, Nicholas Sawicki, and our campaign committee, I am excited to launch the Completing the Walk Capital Campaign benefitting the Co-Cathedral of the Sacred Heart. This \$9,800,000 campaign will endeavor to fund the elements of the Archbishop Fiorenza Plaza as already announced, capital improvements to the Co-Cathedral and Cathedral Centre, and the creation of an endowment to help preserve the Co-Cathedral of the Sacred Heart for years to come.

This campaign is a challenge for our community and the Catholic community around the Archdiocese that supports us, but one that can help the parish to mature and thrive for decades to come. Therefore, I am calling on all of us to join together in Completing the Walk.




Sus padres, **Zacarías e Isabel**, ya eran ancianos cuando lo concibieron.
