

Completing the Walk: Improvements to the Cathedral Centre

Dear Friends in Christ:

Anh chị em thân mến trong Chúa Kitô:

Estimados Amigos y Amigas en Cristo:

"We haven't completed the walk yet. The journey is still going on, but we've made progress...we can't stop now; we have to keep going." - Archbishop Joseph A. Fiorenza

Three weeks ago, our parish initiated the \$9.8 million Completing the Walk capital campaign for benefitting the long term provision for our parish and its facilities by fulfilling the original vision and plan of the late Archbishop Fiorenza. This campaign will work with the parishioners of the Co-Cathedral as well as benefactors from across the Archdiocese, including those whose support made the Co-Cathedral's construction possible in 2008. For those who missed out on the launch or want to know more details about specific case elements, I will use this space over the next few weeks to lay out more details. Two Sundays ago, I provided more details about the Archbishop Joseph A. Fiorenza Plaza. Last Sunday, I turned to the Co-Cathedral itself. This Sunday, we will look at the Cathedral Centre.

During the fundraising and construction of the Co-Cathedral in the 2000s, the opportunity came available to acquire the old Federal Reserve bank to use for Co-Cathedral offices, classrooms, and events. Thus, the Cathedral Centre was born. While a significant amount of money was put into the renovation and conversion of the space at the time, the years have revealed more that needs to be done.

First and foremost, the fourth floor space known as Cameron Hall needs some significant upgrades to audio/video in order to host large events, presentations, and receptions. Flooring, windows, and paint need attention as well. The fourth floor patio overlooking the Co-Cathedral can use some upgrades to make it more usable for events. Like the church, the spaces need some HVAC and lighting improvements for energy cost efficiency. And finally, we would like to expand and repair the parking lot of the Cathedral Centre. In total, Cathedral Centre improvements account for \$830,000 of the \$9,800,000 goal for the campaign.
