Transfiguration & Confession

Dear Friends in Christ:

Anh chị em thân mến trong Chúa Kitô:

Estimados Amigos y Amigas en Cristo:

Today we have an interruption to our regularly scheduled program as the Feast of the Transfiguration, ranking higher than a Sunday in Ordinary Time, falls on a Sunday and thus supersedes the Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. This Feast is a reflection upon the glimpse of divine glory revealed by Jesus to Peter, James, and John to help contextualize the scandal of the Cross when the time came.

In the same way, each of us on the day of our baptism is clothed in a white garment to symbolize that glory we have received as a son or daughter of God washed clean from sin and receiving a heavenly inheritance. When we fall from grace through our own personal sin after baptism, the Sacrament of Penance is made available to us to encounter God's mercy anew and be restored to that dignity.

Since I presented on the topic of the Grace of the Confessional at our monthly First Friday event, I thought it might be helpful to offer some quick tips in this space for a more fruitful confession:

- (1) Be Organized: While awareness of any mortal sin should have you seeking the first opportunity for confession available, it is good to make a personal schedule of frequency so that there is a habit and an ability to track patterns of sin and grace in the spiritual life. Find a time that can consistently work for you and plan to go at least once per month.
- (2) Be Prepared: Do not just run into the confessional last minute and try to collect your thoughts and remember sins on the fly. This does not lead to a fruitful confession. Instead, do a true examination of conscience before going in. Use an examination guide (we have samples in the narthex racks) or find one online.
- (3) Be Thorough: Confess all mortal sins in number and kind ("I committed the sin of XYZ 3 times since my last confession"). Add any frequently recurring venial sins as well.
- (4) Be Concise: Not only do overly long confessions prevent others in line from having the opportunity, but they actually are less fruitful for you. The priest will ask for details if needed, but otherwise do not seek to justify—just own the sins committed without rationalizing and prepare for God's mercy!
- (5) Be Loved: Pray the Act of Contrition slowly and sincerely and listen as the Words of Absolution are prayed over you with gratitude. No matter what you bring in, you depart glowing in soul once again as His mercy endures forever!

Brenda Portman explains: "[This is] light manifested through the **glory of Christ**, who is the Eternal Light...and particularly as he was transfigured on the mountain and shone with radiance before three of his disciples...The loud, crashing chords played by the full organ – a harmonization of the chant melody...immediately floods us with **blazing, brilliant** light. A fugue follows, with its subject also derived from the chant melody, beginning at a mezzo-forte and growing in intensity to a toccata-like climax, leading into a final **triumphant** declaration of the chant, once again with full organ.






