Labor Day Reflections

Dear Friends in Christ:

Anh chị em thân mến trong Chúa Kitô:
Estimados Amigos y Amigas en Cristo:

Monday presents us with that American secular holiday which always marks a change of season—while not officially the line between summer and fall, it does mark the transition into fall activities: a school year underway, football, etc. And of course, everyone enjoys a day off from work.

However, it is in this that Labor Day presents its great irony—an occasion to celebrate work by not doing any! And in this, as Christians, it serves as a reminder of two important things.

The first is the dignity of human labor. Labor is not just something we do because we have to, but is important and good for us! According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, human beings from creation are called to prolong the work of creation by subduing the earth. Our work is a co-creation with God. It is also a redemptive participation in the life of Christ both in his labors as a carpenter and in his suffering on the Cross. “In work, the person exercises and fulfills in part the potential inscribed in his nature. The primordial value of labor stems from man himself, its author and its beneficiary. Work is for man, not man for work. Everyone should be able to draw from work the means of providing for his life and that of his family, and of serving the human community.” (CCC 2427-2428)

The second is the importance of sabbath. In the first creation account of Genesis, we are told that on the seventh day, God rested from His labors. This has been a foundational teaching from the beginning that the Lord’s Day is a day of sabbath rest. This day of rest is meant to refresh us, fill us with gratitude as we have to reflect on the Lord’s generosity to us, and build up relationships as we have more time for family and leisure. But it should also prepare us and fill us with gratitude for the opportunity to work.

Therefore, instead of “working for the weekend”, we need a shift in vision to “weekend for our work”—to find fulfillment in our labors and to use our sabbath time well to be renewed in purpose and gratitude and fresh in body and spirit for the importance of our work. And this priority may require us to rethink how we spend our weekends and vacations. Do we always show up tired and grumpy for work on Monday morning? Or does our sabbath rest bring us back refreshed and grateful, ready for a new day?

O Sacred Heart of Jesus, we place all our trust in you! Amen!

Septiembre: Mes dedicado a Nuestra Señora de los Dolores



Cada 15 de septiembre, un día después de la fiesta de la Exaltación de la Santa Cruz, la Iglesia Católica conmemora a Nuestra Señora de los Dolores.

Origen de la devoción

La devoción a la Virgen de los Dolores -también conocida como la Virgen de la Amargura, la Virgen de la Piedad o, simplemente, la "Dolorosa"- viene desde muy antiguo. Esta puede remontarse incluso hasta los orígenes de la Iglesia, allí cuando los cristianos recordaban los dolores de Cristo, siempre asociados a los de su Madre María.

Sin embargo, es necesario precisar que la advocación de Nuestra Señora de los Dolores (Mater Dolorosa) cobra forma e impulso recién a finales del siglo XI. Décadas después, hacia 1239, en la diócesis de Florencia, los servitas (Orden de frailes Siervos de María) fueron los primeros en destinar un día especial para conmemorar a la Virgen en su dolor.








