RECTOR'S CORNER

October 1, 2023
Month of the Holy Rosary and the Synod on Synodality

Dear Friends in Christ:

Anh chị em thân mến trong Chúa Kitô:

Estimados Amigos y Amigas en Cristo:

Every year, the Church dedicates the month of October to the Holy Rosary under the patronage of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This tradition more specifically links to the October 7 Memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary—a celebration marked on the pre-conciliar calendar as Our Lady of Victory.

This links back to October 7, 1571, which saw one of the pivotal military battles in world history. At the Battle of Lepanto, the underdog naval forces of the Holy League (made up of the Catholic nations of Europe) turned back the incursion of the Ottoman Empire. As this battle was a pivotal moment in turning back the expansion of the flag of Islam into Christian Europe, it was memorialized for the role of the Holy Rosary. Pope St. Pius V, seeing the stakes of the coming battle and the odds against the Christian forces, asked all Christians to pray the rosary on the eve of battle, asking for the Lord's aid through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Following the surprising victory, the date was commemorated by a feast for Our Lady of Victory, still observed as a day dedicated to the spiritual value of the rosary.

Not only do we kick off the month of the rosary today, but this week sees the beginning of the Synod on Synodality in Rome after years of preparation. The synod is seen as a hallmark project of Pope Francis and has been a lightning rod for both support and critique. One could summarize by saying that there is an official agenda for the synod, while some may attempt to bring agendas of their own.

In past centuries, battles for the faith often involved the sword, but today, the rosary may be one of the most important weapons of all. Today's threats to the faith are not found on maps or in armies, but in ideological incursions from within and without.

As bishops and other participants from around the world assemble for this major event, we should be joining them in prayer—not that their will be done or that ours be done, but as always, that the Lord's will be done.

Therefore, please join me in the coming days in praying the rosary and asking for the intercession of Our Lady that they and that all of us may better discern the will of God and follow in humility of heart where he leads. Our Lady of Victory, pray for us!

O Sacred Heart of Jesus, we place all our trust in you! Amen!





Un mensaje del Padre Jeff

Cada año, la Iglesia dedica el mes de octubre al Santo Rosario bajo la advocación de la Santísima Virgen María. Esta tradición se vincula más específicamente a la memoria de Nuestra Señora del Rosario, el 7 de octubre, una celebración marcada en el calendario preconciliar como Nuestra Señora de la Victoria.

Se remonta al 7 de octubre de 1571, fecha de una de las batallas militares más importantes de la historia universal. En la batalla de Lepanto, las fuerzas navales de la Liga Santa (formada por las naciones católicas de Europa), en inferioridad de condiciones, rechazaron la incursión del Imperio Otomano. Como esta batalla fue un momento crucial para hacer retroceder la expansión de la bandera del Islam en la Europa cristiana, fue conmemorada con el papel del Santo Rosario. El Papa San Pío V, viendo lo que estaba en juego en la batalla que se avecinaba y las probabilidades en contra de las fuerzas cristianas, pidió a todos los cristianos que rezaran el rosario en la víspera de la batalla, pidiendo la ayuda del Señor por intercesión de la Santísima Virgen María. Tras la sorprendente victoria, la fecha se conmemoró con una fiesta de Nuestra Señora de la Victoria, que aún hoy se celebra como un día dedicado al valor espiritual del rosario.



Octubre: Mes dedicado al Santo Rosario

El rosario es una devoción mariana que surgió en la Edad Media cuando los cristianos saludaban a María con el título de rosa. En esa época se les permitía a los que no podían cantar los 150 Salmos del Oficio Divino recitar 150 avemarías. Las avemarías significaban dar rosas a María, de ahí surge el rosario a María.

El avemaría es una oración que encontramos en el evangelio de Lucas: "Dios te salve, llena de gracia", es el saludo del ángel Gabriel anunciando a María que va a ser la madre de nuestro Señor. Este saludo del ángel se convirtió en la primera línea del avemaría, oración a María que nos recuerda que ella nos lleva a Jesús. Durante el rezo del rosario rezamos avemarías y meditamos sobre eventos importantes de la vida de María y Jesús.

El Santo Rosario otorga un infinito poder que solamente se obtiene con la fe y devoción a nuestra Madre Santísima, el cual concede los siguientes beneficios para el alma:

- **Unidad con nuestra Madre celestial:** Además de rezar para María, rezamos junto con ella y la invitamos a que reciba por nosotros. La oración se hace más fuerte porque la Virgen siempre recibe lo que ella pide.
- **Arma contra el maligno:** Es un arma poderosa que nos trae la verdadera paz. La Virgen nos invita a rezar el Santo Rosario en cada una de sus apariciones.
- **Aporta virtudes:** Que tal vez desconocíamos de uno mismo.
- **Llena de humildad:** Nos invita a seguir el ejemplo de humildad como María
- **Concede indulgencias:** Disminuye alguna parte de los castigos que tendríamos que sufrir por nuestros pecados, en el purgatorio.
- **La oración perfecta:** En cada decena de las avemarías se medita el sufrimiento, la lucha y el triunfo de Jesús, donde la Virgen estuvo presente para ayudarle a cumplir su misión salvadora.
- **Conversión de los herejes:** Innumerables testimonios de conversión han surgido por el mundo, de quienes no creían en Dios y gracias al rezo del Santo Rosario han vuelto a la Iglesia Católica.
- **Sana el corazón:** Borra la tristeza del alma y llena de alegría y amor el corazón.
- **Aceptación de la Voluntad Divina:** Hace comprender, sin cuestionar, las situaciones que nos cuestan aceptar.
- **Regalo de rosas:** La Virgen María ha revelado a muchas personas que cada vez que rezan un Ave María le regalan una rosa y por cada Rosario completo, le regalan una corona de rosas.


