Prayers for the Holy Land

Dear Friends in Christ:

Anh chị em thân mến trong Chúa Kitô:
Estimados Amigos y Amigas en Cristo:

We have been praying for over a year and a half for an end to war in Ukraine. Now, the thoughts and prayers of many of us are with the difficult situation in the Holy Land with the outbreak of violence last weekend. Next weekend, I will be away from the parish as I attend an annual gathering for the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem, and I know that these events will be weighing strongly on our hearts as we gather in Oklahoma City in support of Christians in the Holy Land.

The first question I always receive during events like this is “is that where you travel? Is it safe to go on pilgrimage there?” My response is to share that visiting the Holy Land is a wonderful chance to more deeply understand the geography of the area as well as reasons for sociopolitical tensions. The unfortunate violence right now mostly concerns the Gaza Strip, which is at the extreme southwestern edge of Israel at the border with Egypt. This is not a region that pilgrims typically approach. The other major Palestinian population can be found in the West Bank, which includes places like Bethlehem and Jericho, which we do visit. However, the ways in which the military controls and segregates these areas has to be seen to be properly understood.

In the meanwhile, we need to pray for peace. Any loss of life is tragic and even more so any loss of innocent civilian life. However, in a very special way, please keep in special prayer the minority Christian population. Out of the three Abrahamic religious populations (Jewish, Christian, and Muslim), Christians make up by far the smallest, constituting only 1% of the total population. Christians are mostly confined to the Palestinian regions and thus are mixed with the Muslim and other non-Jewish groups. Unfortunately, this means they are often caught in the middle and swept up in violence when militants from their region, such as Hamas, engage Israel in military or terrorist activity. Furthermore, when these events harden relationships between Jews and non-Jews in the region, they often suffer loss of employment or freedoms. Please pray for peace and protection for all innocents that this wave of violence may come to a swift end.

And yes, I still hope that you will consider joining me in traveling to the Holy Land (in safety!) next fall so that you can come to better understand this beautiful place and its complex history and culture(s) that all set the background for the Gospels and salvation history!




