Zeal for Your House

Dear Friends in Christ:

Anh chị em thân mến trong Chúa Kitô:

Estimados Amigos y Amigas en Cristo:

Due to the First Scrutiny for the Elect, those attending the 11 AM Mass this Sunday will hear different readings, but everyone else will hear about the cleansing of the Temple in the Gospel. Calling to mind the words of the Psalmist (69:10) saying that “Zeal for your house has consumed me”, John quotes the verse in future tense as applied to Jesus. Needless to say, it always catches people off guard when Jesus gets angry. So in the zeal for His Father’s house, what has Jesus so upset in this episode?

Simply put, the Temple, which is not only the place of sacrifice but the place where God tangibly is known to dwell with his covenant people, has been profaned by turning it into a den of human activity. Instead of being a place that calls people out of normal activity and into lives of deeper devotion and holiness, it has become another place of transaction. The various merchants compete to sell their wares under the guise of worship—yes, animals are needed for the proscribed sacrifices and yes, money is needed to make offerings or buy the sacrificial animals. But the snowball has rolled and now you have marketplace competition and commotion of all the animals and people banking and operating in normal human transactions in the temple. The people meanwhile can take a transactional approach to their worship of God.

We can be all too guilty of the same. I have asked that items not be sold in the church narthex to take this transactional element out of the sacred space, even though those approved to sell are doing so for good reasons and causes. But we can also profane God’s house when we behave in the church like we would at home: eating, drinking, chatting, using our phones, etc. as opposed to the quiet reverence that the house of the Lord should demand from us. We can be transactional when we approach the Eucharistic mystery without recollection or preparation, thinking we have satisfied the Lord’s commandment by sliding in at the last minute (or 15 minutes late) and leaving right after Communion.

Instead, may this Gospel remind us that we are called to conduct ourselves differently in God’s house. Let’s prepare better for Mass, arriving early enough to collect ourselves in prayer. Let’s avoid conversation and socializing inside the church itself, saving it for the narthex or (better yet) outside. Let’s plan not to engage in just another transaction, but come to encounter the Lord with intentionality and devotion. He is there waiting patiently for us.

*O Sacred Heart of Jesus, we place all
our trust in you! Amen!*




PARISH LIFE






