The Hour Has Come

Dear Friends in Christ:

Anh chị em thân mến trong Chúa Kitô:

Estimados Amigos y Amigas en Cristo:

Last year, the Co-Cathedral for the first time observed an old tradition of covering the crucifix, statues, and religious images on the Fifth Sunday of Lent until Easter. As the observance of this tradition continues again this year, I want to share some words from the occasion last year to remind us what this is all about.

The season of Lent is marked by a dramatic descent towards the Passion, crucifixion, and death of Jesus on Good Friday. Before Easter changes everything, we are left with the cold silence of the empty tomb in place of messianic hope.

This dramatic descent is embodied in the liturgy of the season. From the beginning of Lent, there is a starkness, but the tension heightens as the season goes on. In the celebration of Tenebrae on Good Friday, this is captured by the progressive extinguishing of candles until you end in darkness with the sound of the earthquake. The ringing of bells ceases after the celebration of the Mass of the Lord's Supper and does not return until the Gloria of the Easter Vigil. On Good Friday, the altar is stripped bare.

Traditionally, these Good Friday deprivations were not an independent step but the end of a sequence of sensory deprivation through the removal or shrouding of visual symbols (and paralleled by our fasting and ascetical practices of self-denial).

Beginning with the Fifth Sunday of Lent (which in the traditional liturgical calendar begins what is known as Passontide), there is a venerable tradition of covering sacred images and crosses. Much as the glory of the divinity of Christ that is revealed (partially) at the Transfiguration is completely hidden by his Passion and death, our senses are deprived of familiar devotional aspects of our faith.

The Co-Cathedral presents a challenging space for this observance as not only do we have a lot of statues and images, but they are large and highly suspended (especially the crucifix!)—this is why this had not been observed in the past in our particular church. However, I innocently floated the idea by the Stitching Angels a couple of years ago, and they ran with the idea to make this possible. I am grateful to them and to our facilities staff for pulling off this Herculean effort and hope that it may be of aid in our Lenten prayer as we prepare for the total deprivation at the cross and tomb before the shocking twist of new light and life at Easter.

O Sacred Heart of Jesus, we place all our trust in you! Amen!







San José, esposo de la Santísima Virgen María y padre adoptivo de Jesús, nació probablemente en Belén y murió probablemente en Nazaret. Su importante misión en el plan de salvación de Dios fue "insertar legalmente a Jesucristo en el linaje de David del que, según los profetas, nacería el Mesías, y actuar como su padre y tutor" (Directorio sobre la piedad popular y la liturgia). La mayor parte de nuestra información sobre San José procede de los dos primeros capítulos del Evangelio de San Mateo. Los Evangelios no recogen ninguna palabra suya; era el hombre "silencioso". No encontramos devoción a San José en la Iglesia primitiva. Fue voluntad de Dios que el Nacimiento Virginal de Nuestro Señor fuera lo primero en grabarse firmemente en la mente de los fieles. Más tarde fue venerado por los grandes santos de la Edad Media. Pío IX (1870) lo declaró patrono y protector de la familia universal de la Iglesia.


