March 31, 2024
He is Risen!

Dear Friends in Christ:

Anh chị em thân mến trong Chúa Kitô:

On behalf of the clergy and staff of the Co-Cathedral, I want to extend our Easter greetings to all of you and your families.

Today is the day that gives the rest of them meaning. After accompanying the Lord the last 40 days through his Passion, Cross, and death, today the shackles of death are shattered as we find the tomb empty. "O death, where is thy victory? O death, where is thy sting?" (1 Cor 15:55) Indeed He is Risen and everything is changed. Times of difficulty, in society, in our families, or within our own lives, only serve to heighten our grasp of how important the Easter victory is. Christ has atoned for our sins in His suffering and death, He has shattered the gates of hell, and He has risen, opening the way for us to follow.

I would like to offer a word of congratulations and welcome to our newest brothers and sisters in Christ who have joined our communion through Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist this weekend. As we profess our credal faith today, we are invited to be renewed and transformed in grace as we leave behind old patterns of sin and lifelessness to come out of our own tombs and embrace life in Christ.

For some of you, this may be your first time back to church in a while. If this is the case for you, from the bottom of my heart, I want to say welcome back to your spiritual home. There are always many things that concern us and pull us in different directions, but our festive celebration is an important reminder that our Lord Jesus Christ has defeated death and opened the way for us to eternal life with our heavenly Father. We are grateful for our opportunity to gather week after week to celebrate the Eucharist in this beautiful cathedral church dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus that gives visual form to the beating heart of the vibrant Catholic faith lived out in the heart of downtown Houston. We hope that you will remain with us in the days and weeks to come as we celebrate not just one day of Easter joy, but an entire season of it that cannot be captured in one day alone.

O Sacred Heart of Jesus, we place all our trust in you! Amen!

+ Easter Sunday The Resurrection of the Lord +

He is risen! Music returns to full festivity today! Amid the bombast, the Propers often give a summary of the themes of the day. What do they tell us? The introit, Resurrexi, reminds that “I am with you always.” The Communio commands that we act: “Christ our Paschal Lamb has been sacrificed; therefore let us keep the feast.” And two other additional chants make their way into the liturgy today, since it is the highest of all feasts! There is the sequence hymn Victimae Paschali before the Alleluia, an ancient unpacking of the story of the joyous gospel from the eyes of Mary: “Come and say, what saw you by break of day?” The sung Vidi Aquam accompanies the renewal of our baptismal promises with living water – Easter is a timeless event.

If even the required chants of the day have an air of festivity, the hymns and ordinary (Welcome back, Gloria!) are certainly elevated from the somber nature of Lent. For today’s Preparation, the choir presents George Frideric Handel’s “Hallelujah” from “Messiah”. At the Eucharist, the choir offers a work by Canadian composer Stephanie Martin, Now the Queen of Seasons. The text reminds us that although we celebrate “Jesu’s resurrection” today, we will continue to do so for an entire season.

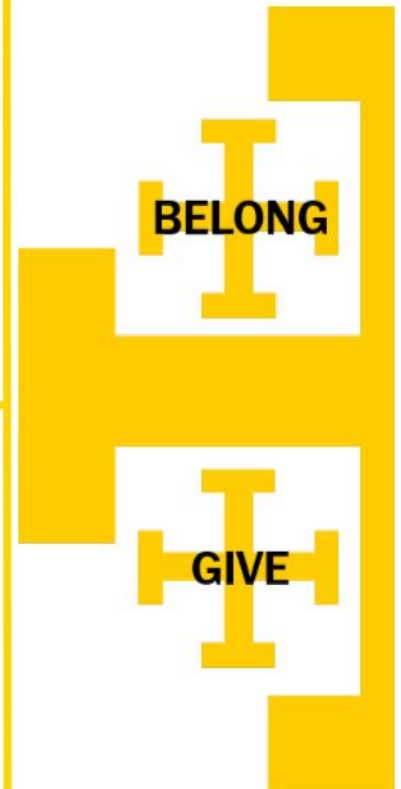

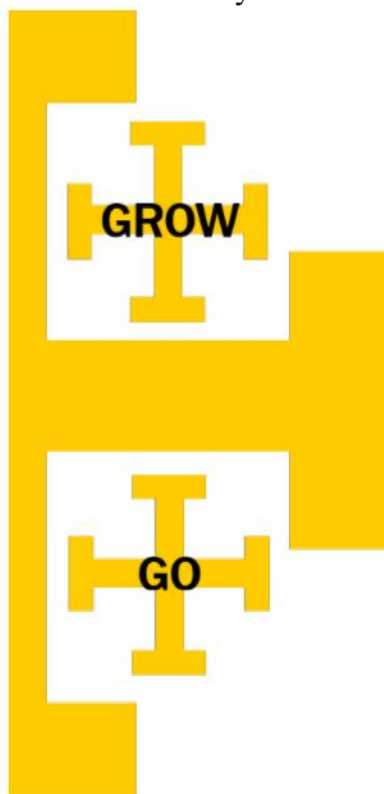

¿QUÉ ES LA PASCUA Y POR QUÉ SE CELEBRA?

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, en su párrafo 638, expresa: La Resurrección de Jesús es la verdad culminante de nuestra fe en Cristo, creída y vivida por la primera comunidad cristiana como verdad central, transmitida como fundamental por la Tradición, establecida en los documentos del Nuevo Testamento, predicada como parte esencial del Misterio Pascual al mismo tiempo que la Cruz:

*Cristo ha resucitado de los muertos,
con su muerte ha vencido a la muerte.
Y a los muertos ha dado la vida.*



¿CUÁNTO DURA EL TIEMPO DE PASCUA?

El tiempo litúrgico de Pascua comienza con la Vigilia Pascual y continúa durante 50 días, hasta Pentecostés. Durante la Pascua, celebraremos la ascensión del Señor al Cielo en la fiesta de la Ascensión del Señor, el 12 de mayo, y el descenso del Espíritu Santo sobre los Apóstoles en la fiesta de Pentecostés, el 19 de mayo.



¿QUÉ ES LA OCTAVA DE PASCUA?

Es el período de ocho días comprendido entre el Domingo de Pascua y el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. Cada uno de esos días se considera una solemnidad, como si se repitiera la Pascua durante ocho días.

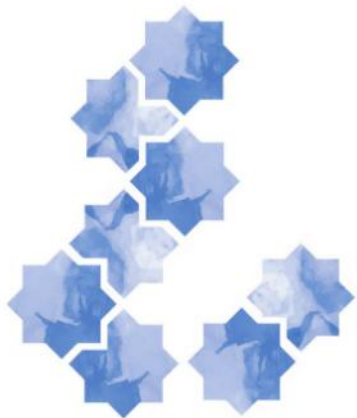
