RECTOR'S CORNER

April 7, 2024
His Mercy Endures Forever

Dear Friends in Christ:

Anh chị em thân mến trong Chúa Kitô:
Estimados Amigos y Amigas en Cristo:

“Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good, his mercy endures forever.” (Psalm 118:1) “Praise the LORD, for he is good; for his mercy endures forever...” (Psalm 136:1). These great psalms repeat this refrain over and over again, invoking all of God’s mighty works. No work is mightier nor a clearer display of His mercy than the Passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus that we have prayed with the last two weeks. Therefore, it is fitting that the Second Sunday of Easter, concluding the Octave of Easter, is also known as Divine Mercy Sunday.

"On that day, priests are to tell everyone about My great and unfathomable mercy." In entry 570 of the *Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska*, St. Faustina records this instruction from the Lord, laying the foundation for today’s Divine Mercy Sunday to conclude the Octave of Easter.

“My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which grace flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or of angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. Everything that exists has come forth from the very depths of My most tender mercy. Every soul in its relation to Me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity. The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the First Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy.” (*Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska*, entry 699)

On Sunday, April 7 at 3:00 PM, at the hour of Divine Mercy, when Jesus expired on the Cross, we will commemorate the unfathomable love of Jesus for poor sinners (us!) with a special Holy Hour of Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. Please join us for this special hour of prayer and worship as we contemplate the great love that God has revealed to us.
