

## Greetings to the Saint Agnes Parish

My Friends,

This weekend throughout our diocese, we are observing Catechetical Sunday. It is a time when we commission those who are engaged in the ministry of teaching and passing on our faith tradition. Besides those who teach in our PSR program, the catechetical ministry includes our outreach to those who do not share our faith through the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation). We provide special preparation for our children who are making their First Communion and Confirmation. We foster growth through Bible study and faith-sharing. It is my hope that we will be able to initiate and share more opportunities between our two parishes in growing our faith together

I am becoming more and more concerned these days that our young people are not being grounded in the faith. They tell us that 50% of the U.S. population today does not profess a belief in God. We wonder why the moral standards of our country are so quickly deteriorating! When I look around the church on Sunday mornings, I cannot say that I see a lot of young families coming to Mass together.

The primary resource for handing on the faith is the family and parents are the first teachers of our children in the ways of faith. Faith is not simply the assent to a body of doctrine that we memorize from the catechism. It is a way of life that has God at its center. It cannot be communicated in the short time our teachers have with our children in the classroom. It needs to be practiced and lived out daily in our lives.

As we ask God's blessing on those who carry out our catechetical ministry, I pray that our parents will be actively engaged in this ministry. Be sure to pray together at home and come to Mass on Sundays. Faith gets us through the difficult times in life. Let us pass this gift of grace on to the next generation.
