

Surprise for Fr. Ernie

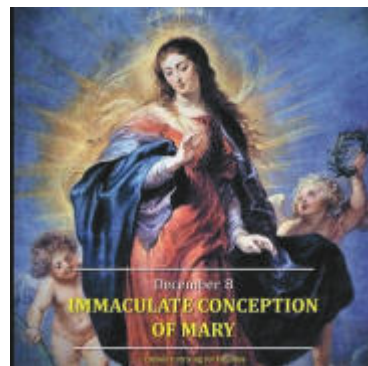
