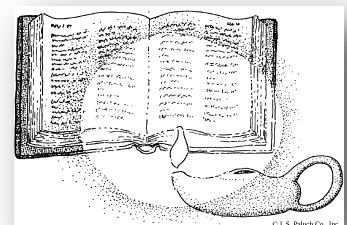

Segundo Domingo de Cuaresma

«Se transfiguró delante de ellos y sus vestidos se volvieron resplandecientes» (Mc 9,2-3)



El relato de la Transfiguración, nos ayuda a comprender que el camino de la cruz también será el camino de la resurrección. Será la experiencia de salir de lo falso hacia lo verdadero. Dios actúa en nuestra historia abriendo el cielo sobre lo cotidiano de la vida. Es un momento luminoso en este viaje de la fe que hay que saber descubrir y disfrutar. Por eso necesitamos una nueva forma de mirar la realidad. Para ayudar a tener esta mirada Jesús emprende con los discípulos el camino al monte. Toda subida implica esfuerzo, pero al mismo tiempo nos posibilita tener una mejor visibilidad y ser más libres.

La experiencia que comparten los discípulos les descubre algo maravilloso, la luz de Dios los envuelve. Esa misma luz les abrirá los ojos para reconocer a Jesús resucitado. Necesitamos momentos como este: Jesús es la verdadera Luz que transforma e ilumina la vida. Luz que ilumine la oscuridad que a veces parece envolver la realidad cotidiana.

Cuaresma puede ser entonces un tiempo oportuno de hacer juntos un camino nuevo que nos ayude a ser más libres para amar, servir y entregar la vida como Jesús lo hizo, para destruir el egoísmo y la indiferencia. Como nos recordaba el Papa Francisco: *“La vida subsiste donde hay vínculo, comunión, fraternidad; y es una vida más fuerte que la muerte cuando construye sobre relaciones verdaderas y lazos de fidelidad.”* (Fratelli tutti 87).

«La espiritualidad cristiana -escribió san Juan Pablo II- tiene como característica el deber del discípulo de configurarse cada vez más plenamente con su Maestro». Pongamos en manos de Santa María la meta de nuestra verdadera "trans-figuración" en su Hijo Jesucristo.

HISTORY OF SALVATION

The first reading today continues the “history of salvation” narrative that we hear throughout Lent this year. Today’s story was among the best-loved in the Jewish tradition (surely Joseph told the story to young Jesus as he formed him in the ways of their faith); the early fathers of the Church were very fond of it as a means of explaining the sacrifice of Christ on the cross. The overall tone of the first reading, psalm, and second reading seems a little incongruous with the dazzling Gospel, until we remember that the Transfiguration was placed as the Gospel for this Sunday precisely to remind us of the glory that awaits those who live faithfully and obediently to the will of God. In the life of Jesus, it is a preview of the glory of his resurrection; for us it is a glimpse of the destiny of those who continue, as we heard in last week’s Gospel, to repent and believe in the Good News.
