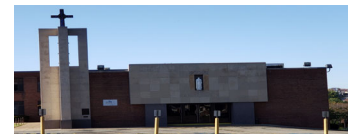

El misterio de la Santísima Trinidad

"En aquel tiempo, los once discípulos se fueron a Galilea, al monte que Jesús les había indicado. Al verlo, ellos se postraron, pero algunos vacilaban. Acercándose a ellos, Jesús les dijo: -Se me ha dado pleno poder en el cielo y en la tierra. Id y haced discípulos de todos los pueblos, bautizándolos en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo; y enseñándoles a guardar todo lo que os he mandado. Y sabed que yo estoy con vosotros todos los días, hasta el fin del mundo" Mateo 28, 16-20

¿Quiénes son la Trinidad?

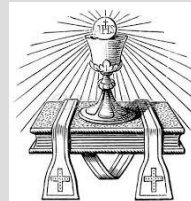
+El Padre: Al Padre Dios le atribuimos la creación de todas las cosas "visibles e invisibles", pero de manera especial la **creación del ser humano, hecho a su imagen y semejanza.** El Padre nos creó por amor.

+El Hijo, Jesucristo: Al Hijo de Dios, segunda persona de la **Trinidad Santa**, lo llamamos, también, el Verbo, es decir: la Palabra, para dar a entender que expresa la inteligencia, la sabiduría del Padre por quien fue engendrado como Hijo único. El Hijo se encarnó en el seno virginal de María. Ella es su madre física, biológica; pero no tiene más Padre que el mismo Dios. Jesús existía antes de su concepción desde la eternidad. A Jesús le atribuimos la obra maravillosa de nuestra redención por la cual nos salvó del pecado y de la muerte para devolvernos la gracia.

+El Espíritu Santo: De Él decimos que "procede" del Padre y del Hijo; tampoco fue creado ni, él, engendrado. Es el amor del Padre y el amor de Jesús e igual en eternidad al Padre y al Hijo. A Él le atribuimos la santificación de los que han sido redimidos. **El Espíritu Santo es el alma que anima a la Iglesia, Cuerpo de Cristo, y que le da unidad.** Es el dador de todas las gracias divinas. Habita en nosotros como en un templo y nos mueve a la alabanza continua al Padre por Jesucristo nuestro Señor.

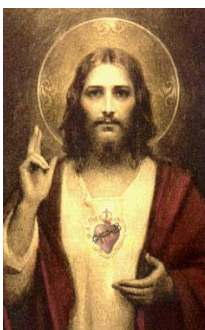

MASS MAY 31- Just a reminder that we have one Mass on Civil Holidays (Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, etc.). The Mass on Memorial Day will be at St. Catherine's at 8:45AM. There will be no 8AM Mass that morning.

The parish office will be closed on Monday, May 31, in observance of Memorial Day.

MISSIONARY COOPERATION PLAN (MCP) SUNDAY will be the weekend of **June 5-6**. We have been assigned the mission group of the Piarist Fathers—order of the Pious Schools—Providence of Central Africa. The Piarist Fathers are responding to severe human and social crisis at all levels. In the English speaking part of Cameroon in particular, a civil war has been going on for four years. About 32,500 lives have been lost, 550 villages burned down, 3000 imprisoned and the worst of it is that about 1 million children have not been to school for four long years.

The pandemic has made it very difficult to evangelize and get medical treatment for its people. The evangelization of the people of the diocese is minimal at this time. Caring for the basic needs of the people the mission group must supply them with food and other essentials. Most of all the people need your prayers and financial support.

Please realize that while the appeal is not in person the need is greater than ever. The poor have been hit especially hard by the pandemic. So now more than ever be as generous as possible. Thank you.

MASS RETURNING TO A MORE NORMAL

We continue to see positive changes to returning to Mass as we did before Covid. The Bishop has given permission for those fully vaccinated to remove their masks if they feel comfortable doing so. Those not fully vaccinated are to continue to wear masks until the state mandate is removed.

Beginning May 31 we are permitted to open all the pews and have 100% capacity. Other changes on May 31 include:

- Being able to bring up the offertory gifts.
- Filling water fonts at the entrance of the church

- Distribution of the precious blood

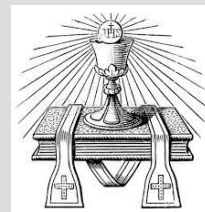

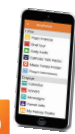
