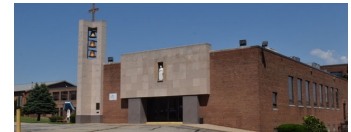

St. Ignatius of Loyola (1491-1508) was a Spanish Basque Catholic priest, who together with St. Peter Fabre and St. Francis Xavier, founded the religious order Society of Jesus (Jesuits). May 20, 2021 commemorates the 500th anniversary of St. Ignatius injury after being struck by a cannonball while defending the citadel of Pamplona, which led to a long period of convalescence that began his conversion and subsequent transformation from soldier to saint. *St. Ignatius of Loyola, pray for us.*

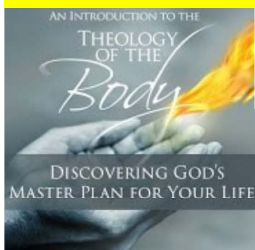
