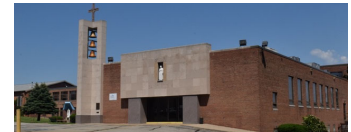

ROSARY TIME CHANGE AT RESURRECTION

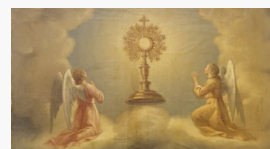
