Adviento quiere decir: “esperar al que viene”. ¿Y quién es el que viene? **Jesús**. Es el tiempo en el que en la Iglesia nos disponemos a esperar al Niño Jesús que está por nacer. Dura las cuatro semanas antes de la Navidad. El adviento es un tiempo de reflexión y esperanza, así como María esperaba el nacimiento de Jesús, así también nosotros nos preparamos para la venida de Jesucristo de tres formas;
+primero reflexionamos en el humilde nacimiento de Jesús en el pasado.
+la segunda forma es dándonos cuenta de que Jesús viene a nosotros en la Eucaristía y está presente en nuestra vida diaria a través de mis hermanos.
+La tercera forma es la esperanza que tenemos de que Jesucristo venga al final de los tiempos.
Nos preparamos especialmente para renovar nuestra relación de amistad con Dios, con un corazón y mente purificados para recibir a Jesucristo de nuevo en nuestras vidas.

WATCHFUL CONFIDENCE

We the Church enter into Advent and the new liturgical year with a call for a watchful confidence. Our readings were originally addressed to communities undergoing great loss and confusion. Jeremiah speaks confidently of God fulfilling the ancient promises to Israel, even during a time of foreign invasion. Paul speaks of God leading the Church into holiness, while the community longs for the coming of Jesus. In the Gospel passage from Luke, Jesus speaks of powerful signs and of great confusion to come, but emphasizes that we may look forward knowing that God brings not cause for despair, but hope. We celebrate Advent to remind each other of God's faithfulness. We are to be watchful, to see how God is stirring up our world. God disturbs both our pride and our complacency, and brings us healing and justice. We prepare ourselves to welcome Jesus, confident that God indeed fulfills all these divine promises. Copyright © J. 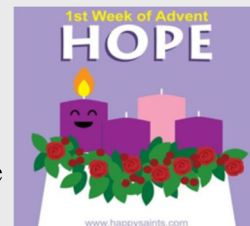
