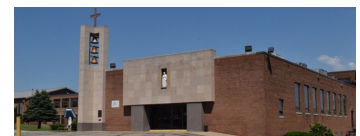

LA IMPORTANCIA DE LA ORACIÓN Lucas 11:1-10

Lucas nos dice que fue uno de los discípulos, viendo cómo oraba Jesús, el que quiso saber cómo hacer lo mismo. Podemos acercarnos a Dios como nos acercamos a un padre tierno. No es sólo Jesús quien le puede llamar “padre.” También nosotros podemos. Además, ese “nuestro” tiene un significado más pues la oración no es un acto individual. Vemos que debemos darle honra a Dios en todo momento (“santificado sea tu nombre”) y que debemos vivir como si estuviéramos delante de su trono (“Venga tu Reino”). El reconocimiento de Dios como nuestro padre santificado nos pone en la posición de pedir su bendición como hijos e hijas. El Señor también sabe que necesitamos nuestro sustento diario (“El pan nuestro de cada día, dánoslo hoy”). Además de ello, el Señor sabe que el pecado forma parte de nuestra realidad. Necesitamos el perdón, y eso no sólo una vez. Necesitamos tanto pan como perdón cada día. Solo podemos recibir perdón si estamos ofreciéndolo a los demás. Jesús nos dice que debemos insistir en nuestra Oración: *“Pedid, y se os dará; buscad, y hallaréis; llamad, y se os abrirá, porque todo aquel que pide, recibe; y el que busca, halla; y al que llama, se le abrirá.”* Y lo que recibimos de Dios siempre será bueno.

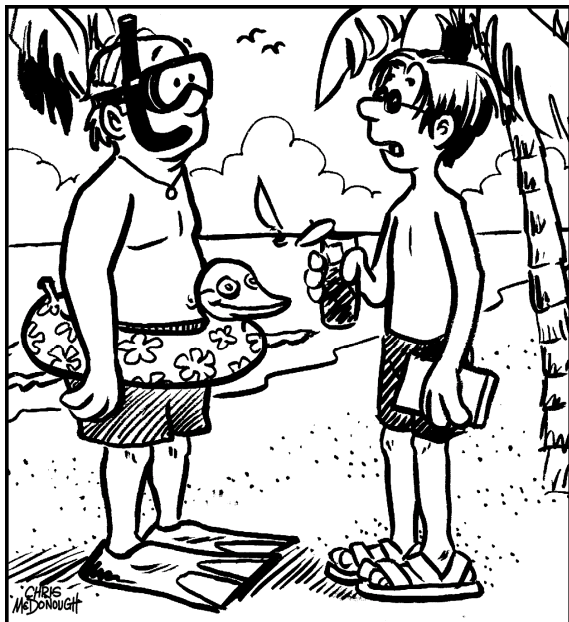
