On October 7, the Church celebrates the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, also remembered as the Feast of Our Lady of Victory at Lepanto. On this day, we celebrate the Holy League's defeat of the Ottoman Empire in the Battle of Lepanto on October 7, 1571. Even though the Turkish forces were very powerful, the Christians were victorious. St. Pope Pius V attributed their victory to the intercession of Mary and the prayer of the Most Holy Rosary since the Pope had asked the entire Christian people to unite themselves through the recitation of the Holy Rosary for the success of the battle (source: EWTN.com). *Our Lady of the Rosary, pray for us.*
