

DOMINGO 25 DE DICIEMBRE LA NATIVIDAD DE NUESTRO SEÑOR

"Hermanos, y hermanas, deteniéndonos ante el belén miremos el centro; vayamos más allá de las luces y los adornos, que son hermosos, y contemplemos al Niño... En su pequeñez es Dios. Reconozcámoslo: "Niño, Tú eres Dios, Diosniño". El creador del mundo no tiene hogar. Hoy todo se invierte: Dios viene al mundo pequeño. Su grandeza se ofrece en la pequeñez.

Y nosotros, preguntémonos, ¿sabemos acoger este camino de Dios? Es el desafío de Navidad: Dios se revela, pero los hombres no lo entienden. Él se hace pequeño a los ojos del mundo y nosotros seguimos buscando la grandeza según el mundo, quizá incluso en nombre suyo. Dios se abaja y nosotros queremos subir al pedestal. El Altísimo indica la humildad y nosotros pretendemos brillar. Dios va en busca de los pastores, de los invisibles; nosotros buscamos visibilidad, hacernos notar. Jesús nace para servir y nosotros pasamos los años persiguiendo el éxito. Dios no busca fuerza y poder, pide ternura y pequeñez interior."

Esto es lo que podemos pedir a Jesús para Navidad: la gracia de la pequeñez. "Señor, enséñanos a amar la pequeñez. Ayúdanos a comprender que es el camino para la verdadera grandeza". Pero, ¿qué quiere decir, concretamente, acoger la pequeñez? En primer lugar, quiere decir creer que Dios quiere venir en las pequeñas cosas de nuestra vida, quiere habitar las realidades cotidianas, los gestos sencillos que realizamos en casa, en la familia, en la escuela, en el trabajo. Quiere realizar, en nuestra vida ordinaria, cosas extraordinarias. Es un mensaje de gran esperanza: Jesús nos invita a valorar y redescubrir las pequeñas cosas de la vida. 

The feasts that make up Christmas Time all illuminate in their own way the fundamental mystery of the Incarnation that stands at the heart of this sacred season. Each celebration sheds its own distinct light on our conviction that, in the birth of Jesus, earth and heaven have been wedded together for the sake of our salvation. The feasts of the Holy Family, Mary the Mother of God, Epiphany, and the Baptism of the Lord all have their own particular histories. But they have been joined together in a single seasonal flow that invites us to trace the unfolding meanings of the Incarnation from myriad perspectives. As we follow the successive meanings of Jesus' birth, his participation in family life, the meaning of Mary's motherhood, the significance of the Magi's visit, and the beginning of Jesus' public ministry, we are invited to explore in deeper and deeper fashion the staggering truth that Jesus has shared completely in our human experience, has truly become one with us, fully human while remaining fully divine.
