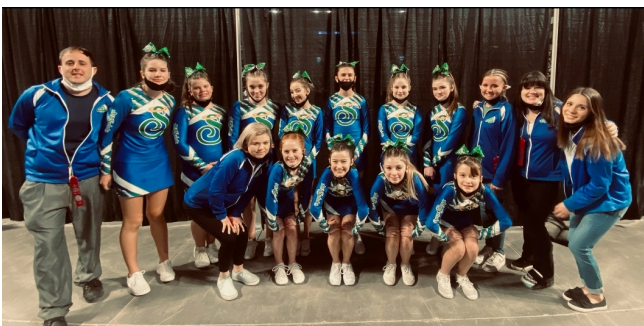

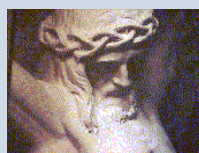
Prayer:
