
#### PRAYER:

### Salmon Project



Our 7<sup>th</sup> grade class is once again partnering with the Fish Friends Program, a Maine organization that provides schools with materials for raising salmon from eggs to alevin. We started with 200 eggs this year.

The class is documenting weekly observations on "Fishy Fridays," conducting a posterbased research project, and learning about salmon as part of our Ecology unit. The class has also been talking about our responsibility to be good stewards of the environment.

Not all Atlantic Salmon populations are in trouble, but the Gulf of Maine Population is endangered and at risk for extinction. This population still returns to Maine through rivers like the Penobscot, but it does not return farther south than Maine. That means that our state, and mostly the coastal region, is the only place in our country where schools can help rehabilitate endangered Atlantic salmon.

### 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Presents Living **Wax Museum**





From King Tut to Jeff Kinney, the library at SJC was transformed into a living wax museum by fifth-graders! The students read biographies of famous people and created display boards that highlighted major events and accomplishments in the person's life.
