- All candidates for athletic teams **and** other school activities must complete and return a signed Athletic and Extra-curricular Policy (by their parent or guardian)
- The Athlete Physical Form signed by a health care provider must be returned to school by August 25th, 2023 and/or **before they can take part in the first practice.**
- Health Insurance and Emergency Contact information must be on file with the school office (via the Emergency and Permission Form on QuickSchools) prior to the first practice.
- Parents and athletes should become familiar with our Extra-curricular Activity section of the Student Handbook.

- Those who provide transportation to children other than their own are expected to complete a Parent Volunteer Transportation Form (available on QuickSchools) and provide the office with the needed documentation. Volunteer drivers must have Diocesan background checks, and attend Protecting God's Children.
- Neither parents nor students are allowed to raise money for any team function without prior approval from the Principal and/or Athletic Director.
- Students are expected to attend practices and contests on a regular basis as scheduled. Exceptions must be communicated to the head coach in advance. Failure to meet this responsibility may result in dismissal from the team.
- The Athletic Director will evaluate all head coaches and support personnel upon the completion of their sports season. These evaluations will be based on the appropriate coaching job description.
