Thank you to everyone who came out to help us celebrate Operation Homestretch. We announced to the community that we have reached **\$6 million** in pledges and gifts! How exciting!!! We are so grateful to the more than 560 families who have already supported this campaign. We are well on our way to reaching our stretch goal of \$7 million! The success of this campaign allows our school the opportunity to break ground on the new school building towards the end of the school year. Our new building will house 10 new classrooms for Little Gators and PK3. It will also be strong enough to build a gym on top of it in the future. Connecting the new building to our existing will be a beautiful new entrance that will honor our Mercy Sister heritage. In that section, the architect has designed a space for a new ADA-compliant elevator as well as bathrooms on the second and third floors for our lower and middle school students. Then once the new building is complete, we can update and better utilize the classrooms and spaces in the current building.

Now we have an even bigger vision for our church and school if we are able to raise \$9 million. If we are able to raise \$9 million, we will be able to build the gym and community center now instead of waiting until a second phase in the future. This will save our community millions of dollars and our current 4th-grade students should be able to walk into the new gym as students of HNJ! We just need everyone to STRETCH the best that they can.

Whether a student holds a fixed mindset or growth mindset significantly impacts their learning experience—from elementary school to high school. Students that hold a fixed mindset give up

when they can't solve a problem, and they admit defeat. This can be detrimental to students' future efforts and leads to limited student growth. With a growth mindset, students continually work to improve their skills, leading to greater growth and ultimately, success. The key is to get students to tune into that growth mindset. What's the right approach? First, focus on strategies not effort. Instead of, "Great effort, you really tried!" say, "That isn't working. What else can you try?"


