

Nurse's Notes

Current COVID-19 Protocol

There are no requirements for testing. If symptomatic, students are required to follow the same rules for other illnesses and return only after being free from fever/vomiting/diarrhea without any medications for 24 hours.

As a reminder, parents are to inform Nurse Abby whenever lice is found and your child is treated. Because we've had several cases within the same grade since starting school, we need to monitor the spread within the grade levels.

Other communicable diseases that should always be reported to Nurse Abby in order to inform the class include pinworm and hand, food, and mouth disease.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HOW MANY TICKETS CAN I PURCHASE?

You may purchase as many tickets as you would like (yes, including parents/adults) However, only HNJ families may ride on the provided buses to and from the theatre.

WILL THERE BE TRANSPORTATION PROVIDED?

Buses will be provided to and from the Saenger to HNJ. Your ticket includes transportation. However, you may opt out of riding the bus and drive to and from the Saenger on your own.

HOW MUCH ARE TICKETS AND WHERE ARE THEY LOCATED?

There are two tier prices available for purchase: \$110 and \$100. The \$110 tickets are located in the middle Orchestra C,R,L section and the \$100 tickets are located in the rear Orchestra C,R,L section. You will be seated with your entire party.

WILL THERE BE CHAPERONES?

There will be 8 HNJ chaperones accompanying the group to the performance. Parents are encouraged and welcome to attend with their child, but you may purchase a single seat for your child and they will be looked after. If you decide NOT to accompany your child to the show, please email Mr. Greg after your purchase so he can notate that your child needs a chaperone.

HOW LONG IS THE SHOW AND WHAT TIME CAN I PICK UP MY CHILD @ HNJ?

Wicked runs approximately 2 hours and 45 minutes (Including intermission) The buses will depart the Saenger immediately following the performance. You should expect to pick up your child between 10:45pm and 11:00pm in the Big Yard.


