How it aligns: This builds on our original goal of differentiation through data but shifts the power to the student, promoting ownership and a growth mindset.

Goal 2: Cultivating Responsible, Ethical Learners in a Digital World

Goal: Integrate digital citizenship and responsible AI use into instruction to equip students with the skills to think critically, act ethically, and engage safely and creatively with technology in a rapidly evolving digital landscape.

How it aligns: This extends our commitment to collaborative, project-based learning by embedding future-ready skills that are both technical and moral.

Goal 3: Building on Home-School Partnerships Rooted in Cultural Celebration

Goal: Foster a collaborative school community where parents are active partners and diverse cultures, backgrounds, and perspectives are experienced and celebrated to build belonging, respect, and shared understanding.

How it aligns: This evolves our emphasis on community and the celebration of diverse backgrounds by deepening family engagement as a key driver of academic and social-emotional success.








HOW TO PLAY

- 1) Make sure you have an adult with you

- 3) Find the "Fingerprints": When you see something on your checklist, mark it off!
- --Draw or describe the thing you found: For most items, draw a quick sketch or write a few words about what you found next to the item on your list
- --Collect (if allowed): If the item has already fallen, you can gently place it in your bag
- 4) Think about God: As you find each item, take a moment ot think about how it reminds you of God. Does it show His power? His beauty? His creativity?

The ABCs of School Success begins at home!

While your child is learning their ABCs, 123s, and much more, they can get the year off to a great start with these other ABCs.

- 1. Attend every day! More time in class = more learning. Help your youngster attend school regularly by scheduling doctor appointments and family vacations outside of school hours. Also, you can cut down on sick days by eating fruits and vegetables, washing hands often, and getting plenty of physical activity.
- 2. Be organized! Forgotten homework? A backpack that doubles as a black hole? Good organizational skills prevent those problems. Together, brainstorm ways for your child to get—and stay—organized.
- 3. Check in daily. Designate a time each day to sit down with your youngster, talk about what they did in school, and review papers they brought home. You might read a story they wrote or look over their math test, for example. This simple routine shows her that you care about what they're learning. Plus, you'll notice where they're doing well or if they're struggling with anything so you can follow up with their teacher.

Strategies To Be Responsible and Start the School Day Right:



The night before...

- Finish all homework
- Put homework into backpack and place backpack in a spot that's "ready to go" (i.e. by the door)
- · Shower or bathe so you don't have to in the morning
- Get clothes ready for the next day
- Make lunch if you don't get a school lunch
- Set alarm clock
- Turn off electronics
- Get a good night sleep



The morning of school...


- Get up right when the alarm goes off or when parent/guardian comes to wake me up
- Get dressed right away
- Clean up and brush teeth
- Eat breakfast or pack a breakfast for the trip to school
- Help others who need support getting ready (i.e. siblings)!
- Grab my backpack (with my homework inside).
- Leave enough time to drive or walk to school
- Arrive to school no later than 8:00am.













Gator Spotlight

This summer, two HNJ alumni, **Jackson Barnes** (Class of 2023) and **Miles Goudelocke** (Class of 2024), traveled with the Jesuit Cross Country team to Flagstaff, Arizona for two weeks of high-altitude training. Only the top 12 runners were selected for the trip. Jackson was one of just three sophomores invited, while Miles was the only freshman to make the cut.

The Jesuit Cross Country program is among the best in the nation, finishing the 2024 season ranked as high as 14th nationally. In this year's preseason rankings, the Blue Jays are listed 7th, 11th, and 11th across three different national publications.

Both Jackson and Miles are already making a mark individually:

- Miles ran 11:14 for 2 miles during his 8th-grade season.
- Jackson posted times of 16:35 for 3 miles and 16:43 for 5000m as a freshman.

All three performances rank among the very best in Louisiana for their grade levels. In addition to cross country, the two also competed for Jesuit's track and field team this past spring, continuing to build on their success.

We are proud of our Gator alumni as they continue to excel and represent HNJ at the highest level of high school competition!




LUNCH PROGRAM UPDATE


