In response to new PK regulations in Bill 409, Kindergarten and 1st grade will now be part of our School Masses moving forward. 








HOW TO PLAY

Speech and OT Screenings

Welcome to the 2025-26 school year! Holy Name of Jesus is offering Speech, Vision, and Hearing screenings as well as Occupational Therapy screenings the week of August 25.

New Orleans Speech and Hearing will provide screenings for <u>speech, language processing, hearing, and vision</u> for students from **PK through 2nd grade**. Additionally, <u>vision and hearing</u> screenings will be available for students in **Little Gators and 3rd-7th grade**.

Please note that students in grades **PK3** and **Kindergarten**, along with all **new students (PK4+)**, are **required** to be screened unless they are currently receiving services or have had a speech/hearing evaluation within the last year.

Occupational therapy screenings will be conducted by Kim4Kids for **PK3-7th grade students**. Please note that students in **PK4 and all new students (PK3+)** are also <u>required</u> to be screened unless they are currently receiving services or have had an occupational evaluation within the last year.




