SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Fr. Innocent Ibeh has spoken of his scholarship for students in Nigeria. Some have asked as to how the scholarship that Fr. Innocent started works. This is some information from Fr. Innocent about his program:

"Officially I have 20 students in my scholarship. The scholarship is structured in such a way that it takes in 5 students every academic as 5 students graduates from high school. Academic year in Nigeria is sectioned into three terms. The fees can be paid termly or yearly. I try to pay yearly.

I have two seminarians and two other students from another school who are not officially in the list. I help with their school fees termly when their parents are not able. The scholarships are only for tuition and for indigent students till they graduate from high school.

I hope this is clear enough to understand my scholarship program. The official name of the scholarship is Divina Caritas."

If anyone has any further questions, please feel free to speak with Fr. Innocent about the program.
