FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN for Sunday, September 17th, 2023

This Year, North Central Windsor Catholic Family of Parishes is hosting SIGN UP SUNDAY on the weekend of September 30th (Sat) & October 1st (Sun) at all our 4 Churches.

If you ever felt the call from God to serve your Church in any ministry, I ask that you please discern this over the next few weeks. In the September 24th bulletin you will see a complete list of ministries that are available for your consideration. Please pray about it!

We bring peace and grace as a treasure to our Family of Parishes when we work and volunteer together in harmony. This makes it wonderful to building up our Family of Parishes!

An Important message to everyone.

Back in July, it was decided for our Family of Parishes to return to the practice of receiving Holy Communion under both species. After consulting a few of our service groups with retired health experts, they advised me that we do not cancel this practice but to postpone until sometime after Thanksgiving. Presently, we are seeing signs of the RSV (respiratory syncytial virus). This is a common but highly contagious virus that appears, like a common cold in most people. It can cause bronchiolitis, the inflammation of the small airways in the lung, or bacterial or viral pneumonia. RSV season in Canada usually begins in the late Fall and lasts until Spring. There is a special vaccine out (single dose injection). This vaccine is optional. Not knowing what will happen, it is better to err on caution for the safety of all our parishioners. I hope and pray everyone understands this and can continue to be patient until we all feel safe to return to the practice of the Cup.

The Sacrament of Confirmation for all our Grade 8 students will be taking place this year on the Feast of Christ the King, Sunday, November 26th at 2:00 p.m. at Most Precious Blood Church.
