GREETINGS FROM FR. BILL

I encourage you to join wholeheartedly in this prayer after each of our weekday and weekend Masses as we entrust ourselves, our families, our parish, and our community to the care of St. Michael the Archangel!

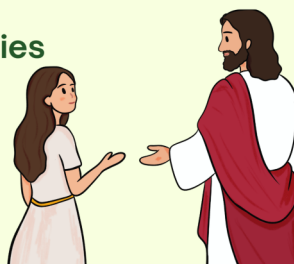

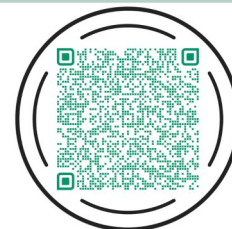

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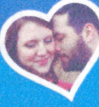
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
