GREETINGS FROM FR. BILL

This weekend begins the Advent Season! It is a season where we celebrate the historical coming of the Word made flesh and born in a manger in Bethlehem. There are many special events and Masses happening in the weeks ahead — please take a look at the graphic below and mark your calendars accordingly!

As I mentioned last weekend, we are journeying through the ongoing Eucharistic Revival throughout our country, encouraged by the U.S. bishops. Consequently, Archbishop Sample asked us priests to preach about the Eucharist during Advent. The 2023 CARA Report (bit.ly/CARA-Eucharist23) found that 95% of Catholics who attend Mass weekly (and 2/3 of Catholics overall) believe in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist, compared to the 2019 PEW study (bit.ly/PEW-Eucharist19) which claimed that only 1/3 of Catholics believe in the Real Presence. 1/3 vs. 2/3 is a statistically significant difference!

So, instead of teaching about the amazing gift of the

Real Presence, we want to focus on how we can *go* be Eucharistic people living out our mission in the modern world. It is through the lens of “Go” (from our parish’s mission to *know, grow, go*) that we want to speak about sharing our “Eucharistic amazement” with those who are not actively practicing their Catholic faith and beyond. Themes of Love/Sacrifice, Healing, Communion, and Reverence will fill our four weeks.

On a separate subject: do you have Joy for working and serving with youth? Do you sense a calling that God wants you to accompany young adults closer to Christ? If so, take this invitation to pray and consider joining our pastoral team here at Holy Trinity. Please send a cover letter and resume to parish@h-t.org if you would like to begin the discernment process for this important ministry position in our parish.

A – O: main/side dish

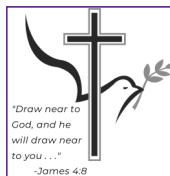
P – Z: salad

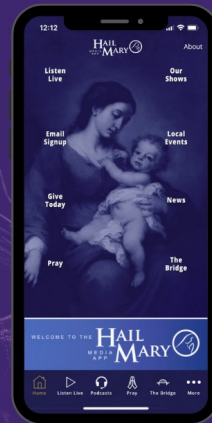
