I told you Advent would be here before we knew it, *and VOILA*, here it is! It sneaks up on us every year, and in our secular, retail-driven society, Christmas has already landed! So, my Catholic friends, I remind us that *Advent isn't Christmas*. Instead of the frenetic pace and relentless buying our world would immerse us in, we Catholics take a different approach and focus as we wait for *IESUS*!

Our role models are *Mary*, the mother of Jesus, and *John the Baptist*. What do these great Saints teach us? First, Mary teaches us how to say 'yes' to God's plan for our lives. Mary's *fiat*, her "*let it be done*", gave her consent to what God had in mind for Mary's role in His plan of salvation. Her 'yes' made possible the greatest event in human history: the *incarnation*, God becoming human.

St. John the Baptist gave a wholehearted 'yes' to his role in God's salvific plan as well! His job is to *prepare a way, getting hearts ready to encounter and welcome Jesus*. Reflect: In what ways is God inviting you to be alert and attentive to the world around you?


