Anthony spent his Pastoral Year (part of his seminary studies) at St. Anne's in Grants Pass with me and he was well loved by the community. We also both served in youth ministry at St. Anthony in Tigard (though not in the same timeframe). I joined him at St. Anthony's last Sunday afternoon for his Mass of Thanksgiving (a traditional event following one's ordination to the

I can testify that we are about to receive a fantastic new priest! Fr. Anthony is a man of kindness, holiness, and character. He has a background in Information and Systems Technology. FOR WHAT IT'S WORTH: THOUGHTS ON FAITH

I'm back from Italy, and what a trip! Like everything in life, it was all about Jesus, and I wanted to share some photos and stories of my time there. My inclusion on this "girls trip" with my sister and niece was a generous gift from my sister. She bought this special tour through Florence and Rome from her parish in Plano, Texas, which is constructing a new church building, to see some of the items being created for it.



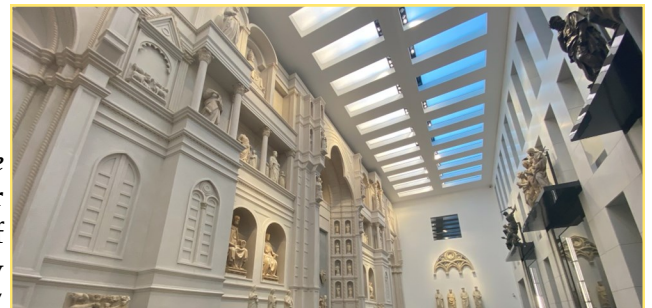
We started in Florence to see stained glass and mosaics (*top right*) being made by *Melini Studios*. Then, we saw the church's marble pieces being made by *Pedrini's Marble Studios*, including their altar (*below*), Stations of the Cross (*bottom right*), and a statue of Mary holding baby Jesus (*left*).



We also saw where the marble came from: *quarries in Carrara*, used since the time of Michelangelo and accessible through long tunnels in the mountains.



While in Florence, we visited the *Duomo (Cathedral) of Santa Maria del Fiore*, the world's largest church (*far left*) – it can accommodate **30,000** worshippers! It has a separate Baptistry in front that dates back to the 11th century. We saw many great sights in the *Galleria dell'Accademia*



di Firenze (right), or "Gallery of the Academy of Florence," including Michelangelo's famous David!



We also took a day trip to Cinque Terre, and stopped in Pisa to see its famous Leaning Tower (*left*).

FOR WHAT IT'S WORTH CONTINUED



On the drive back to Rome, we went through Norcia (also known by its Latin name of *Nursia*) where *St. Benedict* is from and visited *Montecassino Abbey*, where he started the *Benedictine Order*. As a Benedictine Oblate, this was a particularly special moment for me.

Last but not least, *Rome* was amazing! The *Sistine Chapel*, the *Vatican gardens and Museum*, the *Pieta*, and *St. Peter's Basilica* were the highlights.



Did you know that St. Peter's is the tomb for *all* the Popes? We saw them all, including *St. Pope Paul*

VI, Pope John Paul I, Pope Benedict XVI, and St. Pope John Paul II.

For fun, I suggest you rent the movie *The Agony and the Ecstasy*. It tells the story of the Sistine Chapel and shows all of the great works of art by Michelangelo. It's worth watching and you will get a glimpse of what we saw in Florence and Rome, and what a trip to Italy offers.

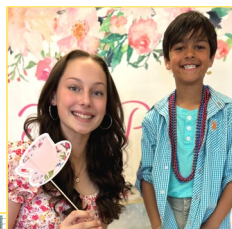
