Fr. Bogdan's Corner

Today is the last Sunday of October and I hope that you found time to say at least one rosary to contemplate the life of Jesus and his Mother Mary. Next Thursday we will observe the Feast of All Saints, a holy day of obligation. It means that each Catholic should find time for the Holy Mass and pray to All Saints for their intercessions. Who are All Saints? They are all those who conducted themselves on earth in such a way that their relationship with God was not broken. And those are our good fathers, mothers, neighbors and friends from the community. For the convenience of the people of our parish there will be 3 Masses: 9 a.m., noon (very short) and 7 p.m. The next day will be the Commemoration of All Souls. It is the day to visit cemeteries, reflect on life after death and offer prayers for souls. It is also the First Friday of November. On Saturday at the 4 p.m. Mass we will commemorate all those who passed away during the past year. The relatives of the deceased are invited to be part of this Mass.

November 3rd & 4th is the weekend for our Archdiocese of Detroit and all parishes including ours to Unleash the Gospel. Over 450 volunteers have been recruited and will visit parishes to ignite the movement, the process. It is the process that will take time to Unleash the Gospel and help us to rediscover Jesus Christ. The invitations are extended to all of us – the individuals, the families, households, businesses, simply to all places where people live, work and spend time. I hope that you will pay attention to the invitation delivered to you from the pulpit, the bulletin and the internet. You must be willing to be part of this movement, to learn about it and to seek more information that will be available. Mrs. Ronnie Gietzen is our Team Leader in this endeavor, and she will coordinate this process – movement in our parish community. We are lucky to have wonderful parish organizations: Parish Pastoral Council, Finance Council, Worship Committee, Religious Education Team, Ushers, Altar Servers and Prayer Groups that will be involved in the movement to Unleash the Gospel and make Jesus Christ more visible in our community. Hard work, humility and service is required from all of us. I am thankful to Mrs. Gietzen for her leadership, to all commissions and team leaders. Another volunteer is Mrs. Kathy Tocco, who participated in the Synod that was presented by the AoD, that stirred the Archbishop to write his Pastoral Letter on Unleashing the Gospel. Mrs. Tocco is a valuable member of our Finance Council.

On November 1st we welcome Mr. Matthew Zinser, who will be joining our staff as our new Director of Music Ministry. Please join me in welcoming him to St. Faustina Parish.






St Vincent de Paul Thanksgiving gift cards needed

All prayer requests are answered as soon as possible. God Bless.


