Thanksgiving is over. I hope you had a good and blessed one. Some positive comments are coming to my ears about our St. Faustina Mission. Fr. Chris Alar gave us good and meaningful talks. One of them stressed the role of St. Faustina in the history of our salvation. At the present time our parish, under the name of St. Faustina, should play an influential role in our society and in our time. We, ourselves, should feel like "chosen people" with the special task. This task is: to give God who is love and mercy back to society, our nation, the schools, and our families – simply to our lives in all dimensions. How easy and happier our lives would be if God would be respected and obeyed. Our society, our families and the world are in crisis because we pull out God from our lives and replace Him with idolatry. It is time to reverse this trend by a movement - called Unleashing the Gospel. It means to take the Bible and Catechism in our hands and start to read, meditate, discuss and encourage each other. Bible Studies and Discussion Clubs are very important. How much spiritual strength can be produced in our houses of prayer and worship? There is a great potential and great future.

Thank you to the churches who were present during the Civil Religious Service at St. Faustina Church. For all Christians, particularly for us Catholics, Jesus is the way, the truth and the life. This weekend we look at Jesus as our King. The Sunday of Christ of the King is the last Sunday in this liturgical year Cycle B.

Next weekend is the First Sunday of Advent and the beginning of the New Liturgical Year Cycle C. Advent is the time of preparation for the coming of Jesus.

Stewardship Thoughts



For the Solemnity celebration of Christ the King, today's Scripture readings profess Jesus' kingship. In St. John's Gospel, Jesus makes clear to Pilate that His kingdom does not belong to this world. In Revelation, the Lord God proclaims that He is the Alpha and the Omega - the "first and the last" - and will reign for eternity. The Prophet Daniel tells of his vision: one like a Son of man coming, on the clouds of heaven verifying Christ's dominion and glory. How should we venerate our Lord and King? As Christian stewards, we acknowledge Christ's true Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity, present in the Most Holy Eucharist. During Mass, we strive to partake of Him in a prayerful, reverent, and respectful manner. The Eucharist is the "source and summit" of our faith. Through consumption of the Eucharist, we encounter Jesus in a personal way, and we are healed and strengthened to do our Lord's work, especially for our needy brothers and sisters. As we internalize our Lord and Savior, may His joy and peace reign in our hearts, and may that joy and peace overflow to everyone we meet.




DRIVERS NEEDED
