# Fr. Bogdan's Corner

This is already the Second Sunday of Lent and it is also a day dedicated to St. Patrick, one of the world's most popular saints. Born in the fifth century in Britain, he became a missionary in Ireland and the Bishop of Ireland. He is credited with bringing Catholicism to Ireland. On Youtube you can find many stories about St. Patrick, the Patron of Ireland. It is appropriate to bring his name in this season of Lent, when we pray more intensively: Prayer is very powerful in the life of those who pray. It increases the level of hope and trust. These virtues, along with traditional Lenten practices, help us to change and renew the entire personality – the person's opinions, judgements and decisions. It is the process that is called in the Greek Language: METANOIA. Our Archbishop Vigneron in his pastoral letter "Unleash the Gospel" is calling us to become part Metanoia: change your heart and through it change you family, community and nation. The change takes place in the light of the holiness, love and mercy of God. The holiness, love and mercy are manifested to us in Jesus, especially when He suffered and died for us on the cross.

As part of our Lenten Journey, there will be a Healing Mass on Saturday March 23<sup>rd</sup> at 4:00 p.m. and the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Monday March 25<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m. On Friday we will have the Stations of the Cross at 7:00 p.m. Our next Pierogi Dinner will be on March 29<sup>th</sup> from 4:00 p.m. – 6:30 p.m.

This week we welcome our guests for the Warming Center. Remember with the additional activities at the parish, office hours may be limited. As always, emergency phone calls will be returned. Have a good week!



# MACOMB COUNTY WARMING CENTER FOOD COMMITTEE

St. Faustina's Food Committee is organizing the Warming Center kitchen and getting ready to welcome approximately 70-90 guests who will arrive on Sunday, March 17<sup>th</sup>. Once again we will be asking for assistance with food donations. Sign-up sheets (perishable items) and tags (non-perishable items) will be available beginning February 21<sup>st</sup> at orientation and in the church from February 23<sup>rd</sup> on.

#### Perishable Items

The following perishable items are being requested:

- Soup / chili / sloppy joes (homemade or purchased) If you make soup, chili or sloppy joes, indicate the number of gallons you will provide. Note: 16 cups = 1 gallon. If you prefer to purchase, Gordon Food Service, Sam's Club, and Costco sell soup concentrate and chili in large cans. We will need 15 gallons of soup or 12 gallons of chili or sloppy joes for each day requested.
- Lunch meat (Deli turkey and ham 1 lb.) / cheese slices (individually wrapped American cheese 24 slice pack).
- Baked goods Desserts: cakes / cupcakes / brownies / cookies. Breakfast: Donuts / Danishes. Please label all baked goods with date.

## Due to potential nut allergies, we prefer nut-free goods.

- Fruit (bananas / oranges / clementines)
- Milk (2 °/o, 1 gallon) / orange juice (1 gallon, no frozen juice)
- Hardboiled eggs (1 dozen with shell left on)

The sign-up charts for food donations will be located in the gathering area nearest to the Family Center. Just put your name and phone number next to the items you would like to donate. Everyone who signs up to bring in perishable food donations will be called to verify the items they have signed up for and told when and where these items will need to be delivered. Please label your containers. Please do not bring any food items unless you sign up on the sheet. If you would like to donate any items that are not listed, please call us first because we have limited food refrigeration and storage space. If you have any questions, please call.

#### Non-perishable Items

There will be baskets with tags listing non-perishable items that will be needed for the week. Please take a tag, purchase the item, and bring it to the parish office **before March 15**<sup>th</sup>. Listed below are some of the items being requested: Soup crackers / cereal / mustard / ketchup / fruit punch / instant oatmeal / hot chocolate (instant packets) / cheese & cracker packets / Ziploc freezer bags/sandwich bags / tissue/ coffee.




