


#### **OUR MISSION STATEMENT**



# **Stewardship Thoughts**



Today's Scripture readings narrate the Apostles' actions after Christ's Resurrection. In the Acts of the Apostles, Peter shows compassion when he heals the sick, which results in a number of conversions to Christ. In the Book of Revelation, John, detained on the island of Patmos for his witness to Jesus, describes to Christ's followers his heavenly vision, encouraging them to keep the faith. In St. John's Gospel, the evangelist retells of Jesus' appearances after His Resurrection to the Apostles on consecutive Sundays. They are jubilant; Thomas indicates he now believes in Christ risen by proclaiming: *My Lord and my God!* Jesus breathes the Holy Spirit upon them and gives them the authority to forgive sins.

Beginning with our Baptism, we, too, are called to discipleship in the Lord. As Christian stewards, we strive to express this discipleship through our sharing in prayer, service, and generosity with our parish and our brothers and sisters in need.

Today, on Divine Mercy Sunday, learn to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet on your rosary.

## **Divine Mercy**

The mission of St. Faustina was recorded in her *Diary* which she kept at the request of Jesus and her confessors. She faithfully recorded all of Jesus' wishes and described the encounters between her soul and Him. Jesus said to St. Faustina, "Secretary of My most profound mystery, know that your task is to write down everything that I make known to you about My mercy, for the benefit of those who by reading these things will be comforted in their souls and will have the courage to approach Me." (Diary 1693) Jesus wanted to remind the world of the truth of our faith which is revealed in the Holy Scripture about the merciful love of God toward every human being. In 1931 Jesus appeared to St. Faustina in a vision. She saw Jesus clothed in a white garment with His right hand raised in blessing. His left hand was touching His garment in the area of the Heart, from where two large rays came forth, one red and the other pale. She gazed intently at Jesus in silence, her soul filled with awe, but also with great joy. Jesus said to her: "Paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the signature: Jesus, I trust in You. I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish. I also promise victory over [its] enemies already here on earth, especially at the hour of death. I Myself will defend it as My own glory (Diary, 47, 48). I am offering people a vessel with which they are to keep coming for graces to the fountain of mercy. That vessel is this image with the signature: Jesus, I trust in You (327). I desire that this image be venerated, first in your chapel, and [then] throughout the world" (47). When St. Faustina asked the Lord about the meaning of the rays in the image, she heard these words in reply: "The two rays denote Blood and Water. The pale ray stands for the Water which makes souls righteous. The red ray stands for the Blood which is the life of souls. These two rays issued forth from the depths of My tender mercy when My agonized Heart was opened by a lance on the Cross. Happy is the one who will dwell in their shelter, for the just hand of God shall not lay hold of him (299). By means of this image I shall grant many graces to souls. It is to be a reminder of the demands of My mercy, because even the strongest faith is of no avail without works" (742). These images represent the graces of Divine Mercy poured out upon the world. Especially through Baptism and the Eucharist.

# Report Abuse

The Archdiocese of Detroit encourages individuals to report clergy sexual abuse of minors and others - no matter when the abuse occurred. Individuals may contact local law enforcement authorities and/or they may report to the Archdiocese of Detroit by calling the Victim Assistance Coordinator at (866) 343-8055 or by emailing vac@aod.org. In addition, the Michigan Attorney General's Office can be contacted at its toll-free reporting hotline at (844) 324-3374 or by email at aginvestigations@michigan.gov.

#### Registration

Parishioners may register in person, by phone, or online.

#### **Baptism**

At least one parent needs to be registered, active and a practicing Catholic for at least six months. Baptisms are the second Sunday of the month. A Baptismal Preparation Class is required for both parents and godparents. The church requires that at least one of the godparents be an active and practicing Catholic. For more information call the Parish Office.

#### **Marriages**

Arrange at least six months in advance.

#### **Communion Calls**

Pastoral Staff members visit the sick in the hospital when possible and take Communion to the sick and homebound regularly. Names of the sick should be reported to the Parish Office.
