
## Father Bogdan's Corner

On Saturday, October 5<sup>th</sup> we observed the 81<sup>st</sup> Anniversary of the death of Sister Faustina Kowalski, the Patroness of our Parish. She was born on August 25, 1905 in Poland. Sister Faustina was Canonized on April 30, 2000 in St. Peter's Square, Vatican City by Pope John Paul II. In her Diary, this Polish nun reminds us about God's loving mercy toward all people, especially sinners. Since she is the Patroness of our Parish, we are going to get the relic of St. Faustina for public veneration. I am planning to install her first-class relic on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 19, 2020. I am glad that selected cinemas in our area for one night only, on October 28<sup>th</sup> will show the movie "Love and Mercy" based on the Life of Sister Faustina. The movie will be shown at 3 theaters in the area: AMC Forum 30 with IMAX, 44681 Mound Rd, Sterling Heights, MI, Emagine Rochester Hills, 200 Barclay Circle, Rochester Hills, MI and AMC Fairlane Megastar 21, 18900 Michigan Avenue, Dearborn, MI. Tickets for the movie can be purchased at FATHOMEVENTS.COM or at the box office. Please consider going to this movie and learn more about St. Faustina and in the context of this movie, about the role of our parish in our society. This movie will be shown just one week after our "Heart & Soul" Event. This first Heart & Soul Event will include a show "Sisters Act Out" at 4:30 p.m. in our church. I hope that many people will express a desire to see this play. Free will offerings will be accepted. Prior to the play, there will be dinner. Tickets are still available in the office. Remember **NO** dinner tickets will be available at the door the day of the event.

This week we began the month of October, that is dedicated to intensifying our prayerful life by saying the rosary every day. There are four mysteries of the rosary Joyful, Sorrowful, Luminous and Glorious. Many thanks to our rosary society, under the leadership of Mary Zebula, for saying the rosary every day on behalf of all of us.

Upon discussion with PFC and PPC, I am proposing to parishioners "CO<sub>2</sub> Program" to reduce the level of pollution in our city. Parishioners who have buried their loved ones may purchase, through the parish office, a tree that will be planted on our property in their memory. By doing this, we may transfer our campus into a small woods that will be "like a lung" for our city – reducing CO<sub>2</sub>. There will be more clean air to breath. In front of each tree, a stone could be placed with the name of the deceased on it. ## **Parish Registration**

#### Why is it important to be registered in a parish?

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times young adults who have moved away for years think they are still registered under their parents. But membership requires signing up - formally enrolling yourself in a parish. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social and ministerial activities of your parish. Your registration affects the parish in many ways. Census numbers can determine how many priests are assigned to a church, what benefits and obligations the community has to the diocese, and how Masses and programs are planned and scheduled. Registration shows you belong! It is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for tax purposes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish. ## **Stewardship Thoughts**



The topic of faith connects today's Scripture passages. In both the First Reading from the Book of the Prophet Habakkuk and St. Paul's Second Letter to Timothy, the sacred writers proclaim that faith and patience are necessary to withstand hardships and struggles. Because of his professing faith in Christ to the people, St. Paul writes this Second Letter to Timothy from prison. In St. Luke's Gospel, Jesus declares to his Apostles that belief the size of a mustard seed can uproot a mulberry tree and plant it in the sea. In other words, just a minute amount of faith is very powerful. Being a disciple of the Lord demands both faith and trust. Faith is God's gift to us. How do we, as Christian stewards, increase faith and trust in our Lord and Savior? Begin each day with a few minutes of prayer and include a couple verses of Scripture reading. Participate in sacramental confession regularly. At Mass, partake in the Eucharistic mystery where Jesus becomes truly present - Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity - in the consecrated Bread and Wine.

Arrange at least six months in advance.
