(Adapted from Celebrating Sunday for Catholic Families by Karen O'Malley)

In St. Luke's Gospel, Zacchaeus went "seeking to see who Jesus was." He found himself captivated by Jesus; first, to go so far as to climb a tree just to see him, then to welcome Jesus in his home, and finally to give up half his possessions to the poor and repay others four times what he extorted from them. Zacchaeus changed his life because of that encounter with Jesus.

Do you encounter Jesus in your life? When do you notice God's presence? Do you welcome Him into your heart? Do you talk to God on a daily basis? Is your life a reflection of Christian values?

Can people see Jesus in you? If not, what changes do you need to make in your life?

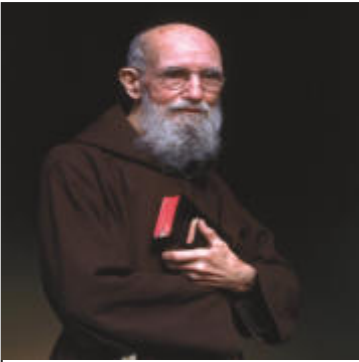


LIVING ROSARY

Stewardship Thoughts

Today, in the Book of Wisdom, the sacred author indicates the Lord's love for His creation - even those who sin so *that they may repent*. In St. Luke's Gospel, the dishonest tax collector Zacchaeus scampers up a sycamore tree to view Jesus in the crowd. Zacchaeus' meeting with Jesus is so powerful that he undergoes a life-changing conversion in Christ. He vows to donate half his wealth to the poor and pay back *four times over* anyone he has cheated. Due to his charitable actions, Jesus proclaims that Zacchaeus and his household have gained eternal salvation. Stewardship, too, embraces a conversion of mind to heart - to encounter Jesus in a deeper discipleship in Christ. Those who experience this gift of conversion will find true peace and joy, not only now, but also in the next world. Ongoing conversion is a life-long process.

Report Abuse

The Archdiocese of Detroit encourages individuals to report clergy sexual abuse of minors and others - no matter when the abuse occurred. Individuals may contact local law enforcement authorities and/or they may report to the Archdiocese of Detroit by calling the Victim Assistance Coordinator at (866) 343-8055 or by emailing vac@aod.org. In addition, the Michigan Attorney General's Office can be contacted at its toll-free reporting hotline at (844) 324-3374 or by email at aginvestigations@michigan.gov.

Registration

Parishioners may register in person, by phone, or online.

Baptism

At least one parent needs to be registered, active and a practicing Catholic for at least six months. Baptisms are the second Sunday of the month. A Baptismal Preparation Class is required for both parents and godparents. The church requires that at least one of the godparents be an active and practicing Catholic. For more information call the Parish Office.

Marriages

Arrange at least six months in advance.

Communion Calls

Pastoral Staff members visit the sick in the hospital when possible and take Communion to the sick and homebound regularly. Names of the sick should be reported to the Parish Office.
