Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are approaching the end of another year for Faith Formation Classes. I know how busy the Fall can get so for your convenience I am offering early enrollment this year. Please find other information in the Church bulletins, and our website: stfaustina-warren.org. throughout the summer.

The cost for Religious Education for next year has increased a little. Tuition is as follows:

\$90.00 for 1 child	\$110.00 for 2 children	\$150.00 3 or more children
\$85.00 (Confirmation)		(\$25.00 Fee for Sacraments)

We will continue to supply students with everything they need during instruction time. If your child(ren) is making one of their Sacraments we will need a copy of their Baptismal Record and/or First Holy Communion Record whatever is applicable. The Archdiocese of Detroit has specific guidelines for Religious Education. A child must attend each grade level and continue their Spiritual education to be ready for their Sacramental year. Therefore if you have a child(ren) making their First Holy Communion this year he/she will continue Education Classes through 8th grade and make their Confirmation in the 9th grade.

Please return before Monday, May 8, 2023.

The teaching staff and I are Blessed to work with your children, thank you for allowing us to build their Spiritual education.

Brothers, select from among you seven reputable men,
filled with the Spirit and wisdom,

The proposal was acceptable to the whole community,
so they chose Stephen, a man filled with faith and the
Holy Spirit,
also Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas,
and Nicholas of Antioch, a convert to Judaism.

who prayed and laid hands on them.
The word of God continued to spread,

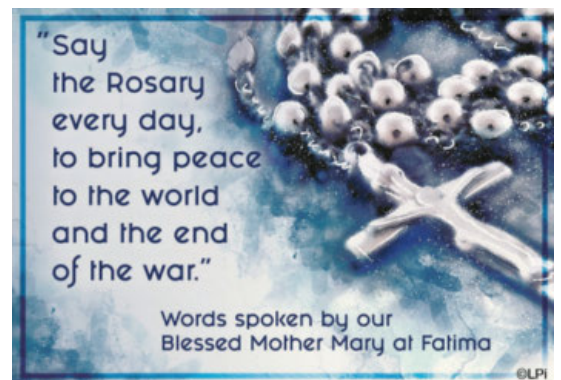

Registration

Parishioners may register in person, by phone, or online.

Baptism

At least one parent needs to be registered, active and a practicing Catholic for at least six months. A Baptismal Preparation Class is required for both parents and godparents. The church requires that at least one of the godparents be an active and practicing Catholic. For more information call the Parish Office.

Marriages

Arrange at least six months in advance.

Communion Calls

Pastoral Staff members visit the sick in the hospital when possible and take Communion to the sick and homebound regularly. Names of the sick should be reported to the Parish Office.

If you have been baptized and have made your First Holy Communion, please contact Fr. Bogdan to inquire about Confirmation.



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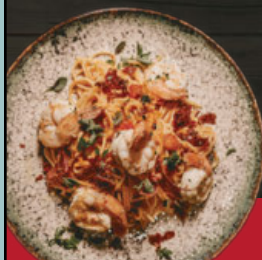
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
