Today we celebrate the birth of St. Faustina. She was born on August 25, 1905 in Glogowiec, Poland and died on October 5, 1938. On April 18, 1993, Holy Father John Paul II canonized her and included her into the long lists of Saints. On July 1, 2013, she became the Patroness of our parish. We hold, in our church, a First Class Relic of St. Faustina and offer many devotions through her. The most significant devotion is taking place on Divine Mercy Sunday each year where hundreds of people are visiting her relic. Today between the Masses, the St. Faustina Relic will be exposed for veneration. After the 11 a.m. Mass, all are invited for ice cream and a movie about the life of St. Faustina. Please join us.

Next weekend will be Labor Day weekend and traditionally many citizens will take off to observe an annual celebration of the social and economic achievements of American workers. It is a time for bar-b-ques, getaways and summer clearance sales. We as people of faith look into the spiritual aspect of this day. We are looking to expand our Religious Education Department. Up to this point we have been able to maintain the number of Catechists we have. Our program is growing and to accommodate such growth we are looking to add one to two more teachers to our program.

I make sure you have a full lesson plan per week with suggestions of different topics, group activities, and a prayer list. I designed the lesson plan so that it is step by step and easy to understand. I also give you full opportunity to incorporate your own creativity in expressing our Catholic Faith to our students.

It is too early to project which grade(s) will be open.

Most shy away thinking they don't have the knowledge or time to teach. We meet on scheduled Monday evenings from 6:00-7:15. Like I already stated I give you lesson plans that are written step by step as a guide for you to follow. I make all copies for your students so you have more time to become familiar with the lessons. We follow the school breaks with Thanksgiving, Christmas, and Easter breaks. We usually begin the last Monday of September and go on until the second week in May. Our first class this year is Monday, September 23, 2024. We try to schedule only three Monday's a month.

There is a certification process that you can do online at your leisure. We can discuss this when we meet.

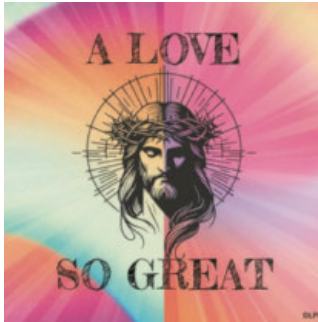
Second Reading:

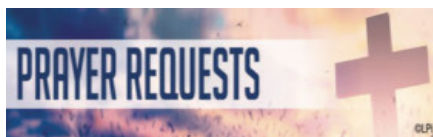

Registration

Parishioners may register in person, by phone, or online.

Baptism

At least one parent needs to be registered, active and a practicing Catholic for at least six months. A Baptismal Preparation Class is required for both parents and godparents. The church requires that at least one of the godparents be an active and practicing Catholic. For more information call the Parish Office.

Marriages

Arrange at least six months in advance.

Communion Calls

Pastoral Staff members visit the sick in the hospital when possible and take Communion to the sick and homebound regularly. Names of the sick should be reported to the Parish Office.
