Epiphany, Little Christmas Three Kings' Day is celebrated on the 4th of January in the United States and Ireland. Epiphany is more commonly known as Feast of the Epiphany to the rest of the world. Epiphany commonly known as Three Kings' Day, is the celebration when the three wise men visited baby Jesus.

Epiphany is a Christian Feast Day that celebrates the revelation of God the Son as a human being in Jesus Christ. Western Christians commemorate principally (but not solely) the visitation of the Biblical Magi to the Baby Jesus, and thus Jesus' physical manifestation to the Gentiles. Eastern Christians commemorate the baptism of Jesus in the Jordan River, seen as his manifestation to the world as the Son of God. The Baptism of Jesus is being celebrated the weekend after Epiphany. The Epiphany of the Lord will be celebrated on the weekend of January 4th in the Church. A separate celebration of the Baptism of the Lord will be celebrated on Sunday, January 11th.
