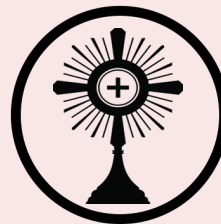

Holy Week Celebrations - April 3rd - 9th, 2023:

Mass of Chrism (April 3rd): All of the priests of the Diocese of London will gather for a period of reflection in London on Monday. Bishop Fabbro will celebrate the Mass of Chrism in the evening at which time he will bless the oils that will be used for the celebration of sacraments. The priests in attendance will renew their priestly vows. All are welcome to attend.

Mass of the Last Supper (April 6th): A bilingual Mass celebrated by both priests will be offered at 6:30pm at St. Joseph Church on Holy Thursday. There will be Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 7:30pm until 10:00pm. Benediction will conclude the time of Adoration.

Good Friday Service (April 7th): A Good Friday Service will be offered at St. Paul at 11:00am. It will include the Veneration of the Cross, but NO COMMUNION. There will be a 3:00pm English Service at Sacred Heart with Veneration and Communion. Additionally, at 3:00pm there will be a bilingual Service at St. Joseph with Veneration and Communion.

Easter Vigil (April 8th): The Easter Vigil will be celebrated at St. Paul beginning at 8:00pm. This will include the Sacrament of Confirmation. Following Mass, there will be a parish reception for all parishioners in attendance.

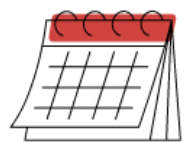

Readings for Next Week (April 9th): Easter Sunday

1st Reading - Acts 10.34a, 37-43

Peter began to speak: "You know the message that spread throughout Judea, beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John announced: how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power; how he went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.

"We are witnesses to all that he did both in Judea and in Jerusalem. They put him to death by hanging him on a tree; but God raised him on the third day and allowed him to appear, not to all the people but to us who were chosen by God as witnesses, and who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead

"He commanded us to preach to the people and to testify that he is the one ordained by God as judge of the living and the dead. All the Prophets testify about him that everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins through his name."

2nd Reading - Colossians 3.1-4

Brothers and sisters: If you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth, for you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in

God. When Christ who is your life is revealed, then you also will be revealed with him in glory.

Gospel - John 20.1-9

Early on the first day of the week, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene came to the tomb and saw that the stone had been removed from the tomb. So she ran and went to Simon Peter and the other disciple, the one whom Jesus loved, and said to them, "They have taken the Lord out of the tomb, and we do not know where they have laid him."

Then Peter and the other disciple set out and went toward the tomb. The two were running together, but the other disciple outran Peter and reached the tomb first. He bent down to look in and saw the linen wrappings lying there, but he did not go in.

Then Simon Peter came, following him, and went into the tomb. He saw the linen wrappings lying there, and the cloth that had been on Jesus' head, not lying with the linen wrappings but rolled up in a place by itself. Then the other disciple, who reached the tomb first, also went in, and he saw and believed; for as yet they did not understand the Scripture, that he must rise from the dead.


