- ☐ All youth in need of court-ordered community service hours must first be interviewed by the Director of Operations or their agent.
- ☐ A parent, legal guardian, or probation officer should also attend the interview appointment.
- ☐ No youth will be permitted to complete court-ordered community service if a sexually-oriented or violent offense (as listed below) has been committed.
- ☐ No court-ordered community service youth will be permitted to volunteer until the Pennridge FISH staff has determined that the above offenses have not been committed.
