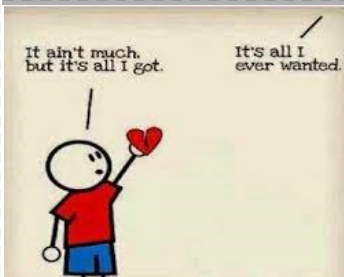

The Bishop's annual collection, the "Annual Catholic Appeal" has begun for 2021-22. This collection is one of the primary ways in which the Diocese funds its yearly operating budget. The goal this year is \$1.8 million diocese wide.

There are extra envelopes in the back of the church if you need one. Prayerfully consider what amount you can contribute. We invite you to make any size donation. No amount is too small.

As of November 12th, 2021:

Holy Trinity— 12 pledges have been made for a total gift of \$3,345, which is 26% of our goal of \$12,750.

Twelve Apostles— 20 pledges have been made for a total gift of \$6,781 which is 38% of our goal of \$17,750.

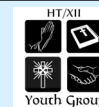
