STATIONS OF THE CROSS



It has been a Catholic tradition through the centuries to meditation on the Way of the Cross, so that it becomes our way of life. People longed to travel to the Holy Land and make a personal journey along the places where Jesus endured his suffering, death, and resurrection. But it was impossible to make such hard

travel, considering the challenges of the transportation system in the past.

So, every church designed the Stations of the Cross in such way that people can experience the Passion of Christ without travelling to the Holy Land.

The Sacred Congregation for the Divine Worship recommends that the traditions of the Cross should emphasize that the suffering and resurrection of Christ are one redemptive mystery.

You all are welcome to participate on the Stations of the Cross at 7 p.m. during Lent as our preparation for Easter.

PLEASE NOTE: On Friday, March 08 the Stations of the Cross will begin at 10:30 a.m. On Good Friday (March 29) Stations of the Cross will begin at 7:30 p.m.
