This letter was received on 11 February 2025.

Dear Msgr. Joseph Muldoon,

I just received your voluntary offer of resignation as pastor because you have reached the age of 75 in a letter dated 8 January 2025. In the letter you offered to continue your current responsibilities at Holy Cross Parish. You have been pastor at Holy Cross since 2024. I appreciate your efforts in the parish. As the Archbishop of Ottawa-Cornwall, I hereby accept your resignation which will be promulgated at a later date. Until that time, I wish you to continue as pastor of Holy Cross Parish...

POPE'S PASTORAL WORKS—MAY 25

The old questions always return: 'How does God's love abide in anyone who has the world's goods and see a brother or sister in need and yet refuses help?' (1 Jn 3:17) -- Pope Francis, Evangelii Gaudium, 187

Revelation keeps our feet firmly rooted in our present struggles to live the Christian life; but it also focuses our eyes on what is to come. The world's indomitable powers, despite present appearances, will be overcome. In the meanwhile, John is inviting us to turn away from the false values and powers of the world and focus on the vision of the new Holy City where we will dwell with God and one another. How does our hope in a permanent future with God affect our lives now? What signs do I see that strengthen my hope in the power of good over evil?

God's love, mercy and goodness lie at the foundation of every vocation, including that of the pope. Pope Leo XIV said. "Let us ask the Lord for the grace to cultivate and spread his charity and to become true neighbors to one another," he said,

paraphrasing his predecessor, Pope Francis, in a homily at Rome's Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls May 20.
