### BACKGROUND ON THE ST. MICHAEL PRAYER

Regarding the St. Michael prayer specifically, this prayer has an interesting history. It is said that Pope Leo XIII had a terrible <u>vision where he saw Satan</u> telling God he only needed a hundred years to destroy the church. Some versions of the story say that, in a scenario reminiscent of the Book of Job in the Old Testament, God permitted Satan to act, and the consequence was the horrors of the 20th century.

After he had this vision, Pope Leo XIII composed the St. Michael prayer for the sake of the church's spiritual protection. In 1886, he required that this prayer be said after every "low Mass" in the older ritual. Though the St. Michael prayer is no longer mandated in our post-Vatican II Mass, it can still be a beautiful and spiritually beneficial custom to pray it after the final blessing as a community.
