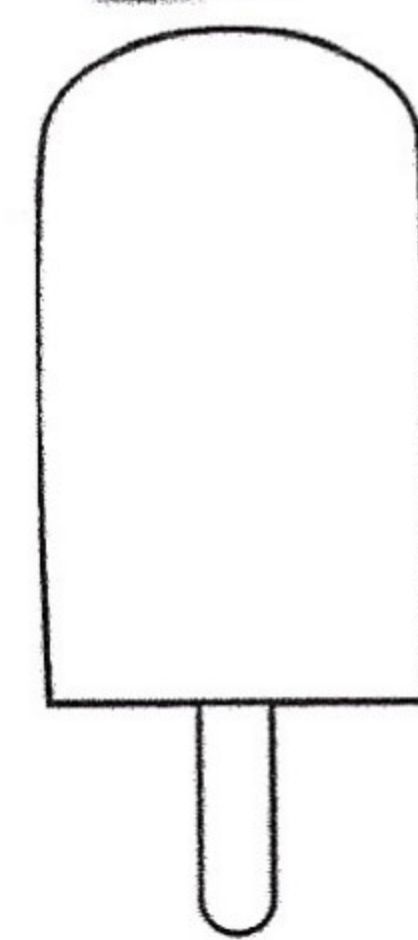


First Grade Summer Assignment
